Dear Secretary Buttigieg:

We are pleased to write this letter in support of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation's (ODOT) application for funding through the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) program. The project would invest in multimodal improvements to the intersection of U.S. Highway 75(US-75) and 81st Street in Tulsa.

The *Multimodal Improvements to Safely Connect Tulsa at US-75 and 81st Street Interchange* project seeks to address the current challenges presented in the narrow crossing of 81st Street under US-75. Current conditions have made this intersection unsuitable for multimodal transportation, particularly with pedestrian and bicycle traffic. 81st Street under US-75 has a one-foot shoulder against a retaining wall giving bicycle and pedestrian users very little room to use the facility. There is inadequate room to expand roadway width under the bridge which prevents the addition of multimodal infrastructure.

In an effort to increase safety and accessibility, ODOT has proposed to reconstruct the interchange with expansion of the US-75 bridge and will tie a multi-use trail along the interchange into Tulsa's current trail system plans. A federal investment through RAISE will ensure that ODOT can construct resilient infrastructure that encourages multimodal transportation through the addition of multi-use trails under a new bridge connection on US-75. This network improvement eases the obstacle of crossing US-75 for bicyclist, pedestrians, and other users without vehicles.
