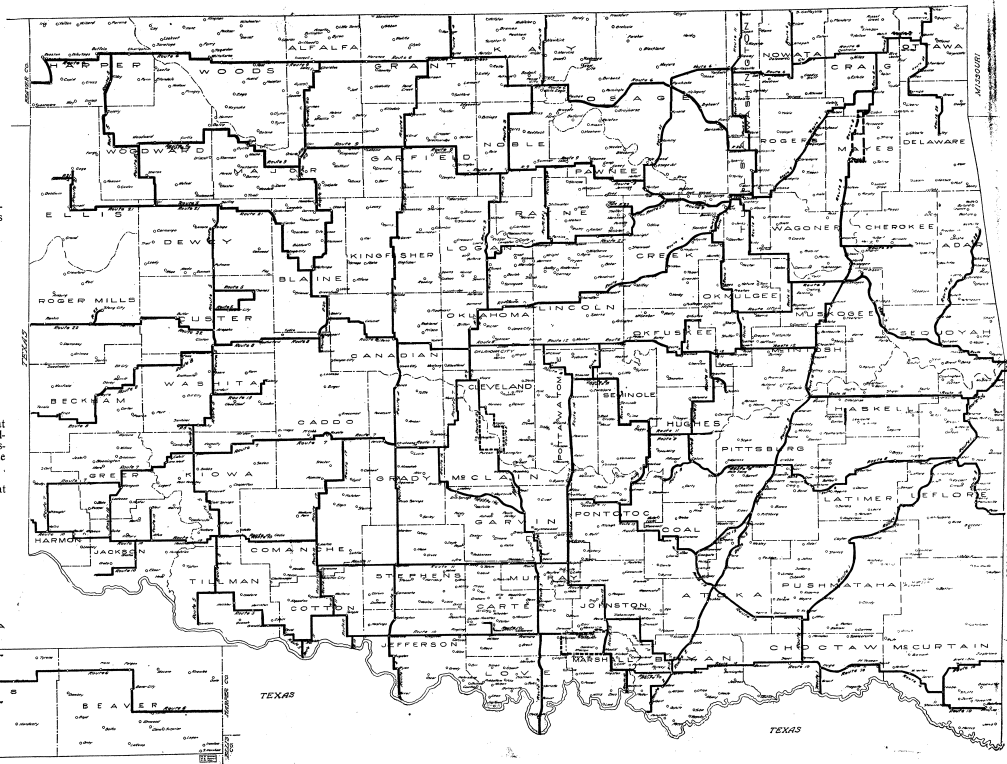
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:
