Project

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing to improve the SH-136 roadway from US-412, extending south 2.5 miles to south of Road Y, in Texas County. This existing segment of SH-136 consists of two 12-foot-wide driving lanes with no shoulders, creating a narrow roadway.

Purpose

The purpose of this project is to improve the safety of the highway as a continuation of planned improvement from the Texas State line to the City of Guymon.

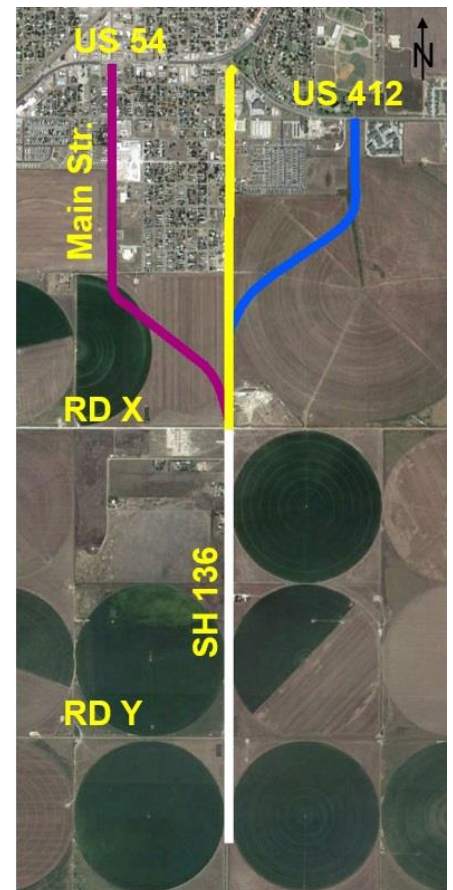
Alternatives

Alternative A: Do nothing and maintain existing conditions.

Alternative B: Improve existing SH-136 alignment to provide two, 12-foot-wide driving lanes and 8-foot-wide paved shoulders from Road X north to 12th St., then transition to two, 12-foot-wide driving lanes, a 14-foot-wide center turn lane, curb and gutter, open ditches and sidewalks to US-412.

Alternative C: Improve roadway with a new alignment to the west of SH-136 using Main Street to provide two, 12-foot-wide driving lanes and 8-foot-wide paved shoulders from existing SH-136 to 12th Street. At 12th Street transition to two, 12-foot-wide driving lanes, a 14-foot-wide center turn lane, curb and gutter, storm sewer and sidewalks.

Alternative D: Improve roadway with a new alignment to the east of SH-136 beginning at Road X, extending northeast to connect with US-412 to provide two, 12-foot-wide driving lanes and 8-foot-wide paved shoulders with open ditches. (Preferred Alternative)



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
