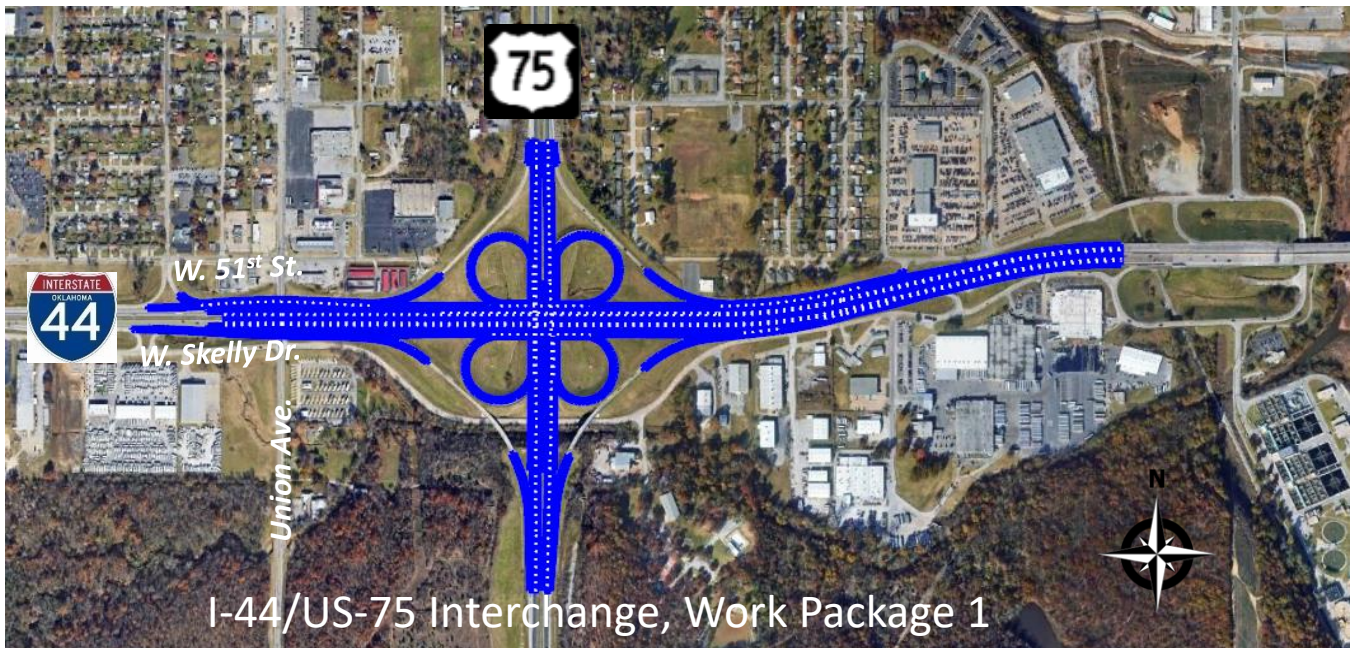

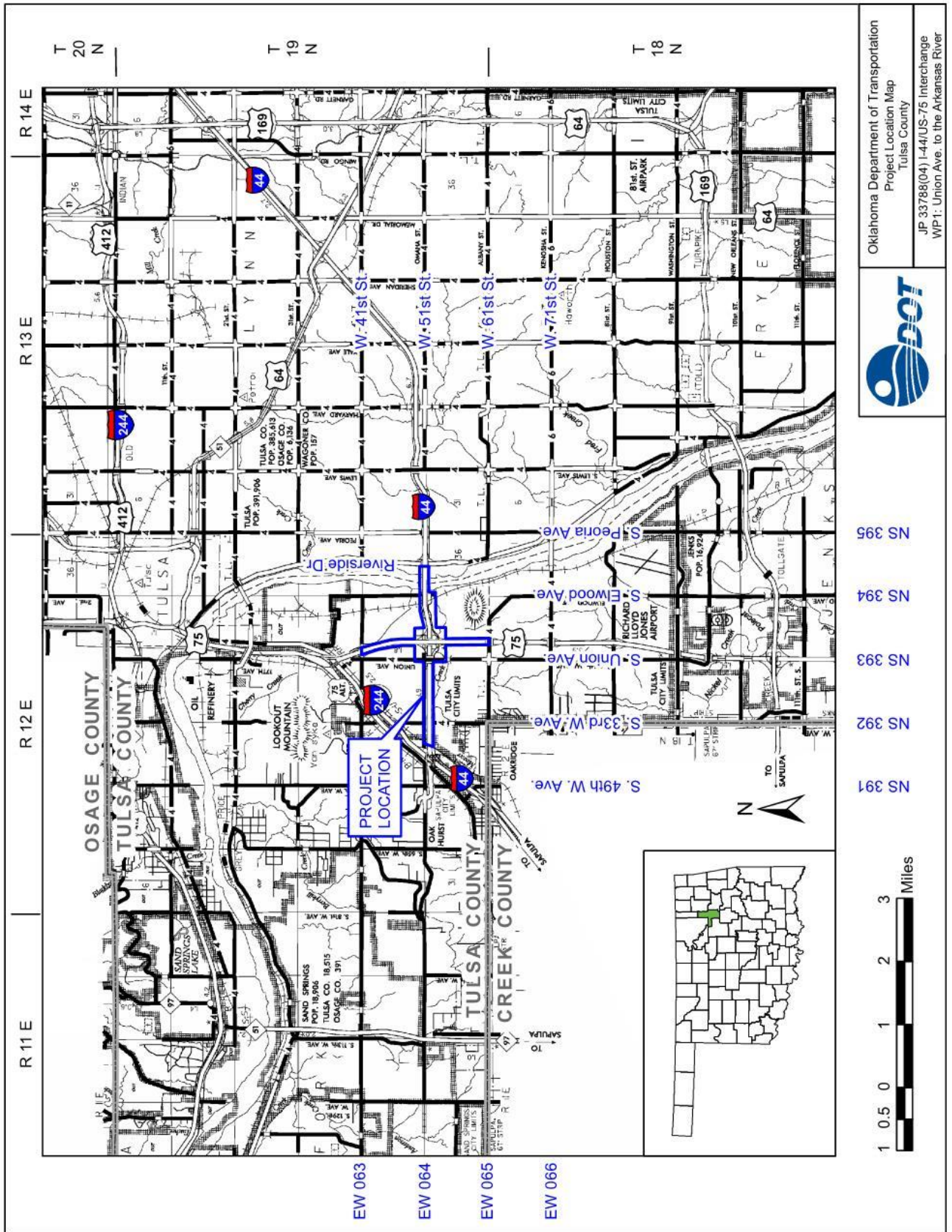
The purpose of this Open House is to update the public on proposed improvements to the I-44 corridor, including the I-44/US-75 interchange, in Tulsa, Oklahoma. This stretch of highway has a high vehicle collision rate and will not adequately accommodate future traffic volumes. ODOT has reviewed several design options which were evaluated and compiled into a preferred alternative for the corridor. This project, scheduled to begin construction in 2020, is the first in a series of five construction projects (Work Packages) required to complete the corridor improvements. The purpose of the project is to improve future mobility on I-44 for passenger vehicles and freight, and improve safety in the corridor.
