1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) held a virtual open house public meeting for US 70 eastbound and westbound lanes from 0.23 miles east of Brock Road in Lone Grove east 3.62 miles to just east of I-35 in Ardmore in Carter County. The purpose of the open house public meeting was to present the proposed design for this roadway improvement. The purpose and need of the project is to improve the pavement condition, highway safety and operations.

The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) document was approved by Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) on April 14, 2023.

The virtual open house public meeting was held October 24 through November 7, 2023. The virtual public meeting had audio instruction and download script options with Stations including a sign in sheet, frequently asked questions, a project overview board, project overview presentation, construction phasing video, next steps board and public comments process board. The fifth, and last station, contained the interactive comment map, relocation assistance brochure, property rights brochure and a comment form.

The open house public meeting had thirteen (13) participants that signed into the virtual open house public meeting, no phone calls were received, two (2) citizen written comments were received. No public officials' comments were received.

2.0 INTRODUCTION

This document summarizes a virtual open house public meeting conducted for US 70 eastbound and westbound lanes from 0.23 miles east of Brock Road in Lone Grove east 3.62 miles to just east of I-35 in Ardmore in Carter County. The purpose of the open house public meeting was to present the proposed design for this roadway improvement. The purpose and need of the project is to improve the pavement condition, highway safety and operations.

The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) document was approved by Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) on April 14, 2023.

ODOT, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing roadway improvements on US 70 eastbound and westbound lanes. The existing US-70 roadway consists of four (4) 12-foot-wide driving lanes, a 42-foot-wide median with 10-foot-wide outside and 4-foot-wide inside paved shoulders. The roadway is in poor pavement condition and has vertical curves that cause sight distance issues.

The proposed improvement consists of reconstructing the existing US-70 roadway to provide four (4) 12-foot-wide driving lanes, a 40-foot-wide median with 10-foot-wide outside and 4-foot-wide inside paved shoulders on existing alignment and provides vertical curve corrections. Left turn-lanes will be added at median openings and right-turn lanes will be added at all major intersections. Median openings may remain in place, be moved, or removed along the project to reduce the number of turning movements. Traffic signalization will be replaced at Plainview Road and Michelin Road. New right-of-way will be required.

The road will remain open during construction.

3.0 OPEN HOUSE PUBLIC MEETING

3.1 MEETING NOTIFICATION

Ninety-one (91) property owners, ten (10) utility owners and eighteen (18) stakeholders were identified adjacent to the study area, which is largely commercial and residential. These owners were notified of the virtual open house public meeting by postcard mailed October 23, 2023.

Thirty-seven (37) invitation letters to the public meeting were mailed to various agencies and members of the public on October 23, 2023. The public officials meeting invitation list included ODOT Commissioners, Carter County Commissioners, State and U.S. elected officials, City of Ardmore and City of Lone Grove, Southern Oklahoma Development Authority, Plainview Public School, Lone Grove School District, Ardmore and Lone Grove Police and Fire Departments, and Tribal Nations.

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
3.2 OUTREACH

Outreach was provided by direct mailing by the post office to one (1) mail delivery route along the project area as noted in blue in map 1 below. Five-hundred-seventy (570) postcards were printed and mailed by Mercury Press Plus and direct mailed to the Post Office for distribution to routes.

Direct mailing helps to ensure that individuals who are leasing property within the study area will get the information, as well as the property owners receiving notification through the mail. As the postal route serves a larger area, more people who use the US-70 roadway received the information, increasing the opportunity for input.

The virtual public meeting had audio instruction and download script options. The first station contained the sign in sheet, download FAQ, and download script. The second station contained the project overview board and project overview presentation. The third station contained the construction phasing video. The fourth station contained the nest steps board and public comments process board. The fifth, and last station, contained the interactive comment map, relocation assistance brochure, property rights brochure and comment form.

All comments were requested to be received on or before November 7, 2023. Written comments could be submitted by mail or email or on the webpage. The interactive map also had a place to leave comments.

WRITTEN COMMENTS

An Additional Lane

This stretch of highway is the most congested highway in the County during the morning and evening commute. An additional lane would be better than a wider shoulder.

ODOT Response: Based on existing and future traffic volumes the existing 4-lane facility is adequate to handle the traffic. The improvements to the operation of the roadway, including added signals and addressing median opening will improve safety.
