The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) will host an in-person Open House to inform the public of the proposed improvements to SH-9 starting just east of the Kings Creek bridge outside of Whitefield and extending east roughly 4 miles in Haskell County, OK. At the Open House, the public can ask questions, learn about the proposed construction activities, sequencing, and scheduling, provide input, and submit comments. It will be a comeand-go format with no formal presentation. PROJECT OVERVIEW

Project Limits

Starting just east of the Kings Creek bridge outside of Whitefield, and extending ~4 miles east towards Stigler, OK

Purpose

Improve the safety of SH-9 by correcting deteriorating pavement, narrow shoulders, poor traffic flow, & limited sight distances, and by correcting five narrow box bridges

Proposed Improvements

- Widen & reconstruct SH-9 to create two 12-foot-wide driving lanes with 10-foot-wide paved shoulders
- Add an alternating 12-foot-wide passing lane with a 4-foot-wide shoulder
- Realign angled intersections, roads, drives & entrances
- Correct steep dips and hills to improve sight distances
- Lengthen the box bridges to create a 44-foot-wide roadway clearance
