The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) will host a virtual public open house to present an overview of the proposed improvements to US-169 starting from East 66th Street North and extending north two miles to East 86th Street North in Owasso, Oklahoma. This virtual open house will present the purpose and need for the project and the proposed design, and will allow the public to submit comments. This will be a web-based format (i.e., no in-person meeting). The information will be available beginning August 5, 2024 and comments are requested by September 2, 2024.

- Start: East 66th Street N
- End: East 86th Street N

PURPOSE

- Improve safety
- Add traffic capacity
- Meet local & regional travel demands

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Add a 3rd driving lane for north- and southbound US169 traffic
- Construct a concrete median barrier to separate traffic
- Install highway lighting along median
- Mill & overlay existing lanes to create smooth & consistent pavement
