Questions and Answers

- 1.) Would it be acceptable to conduct some 5310 reviews remotely via Microsoft Teams or another virtual platform in an effort to be efficient with travel costs, or do all review need to be inperson/on-site? We prefer them to be in person.
- 2.) How do Tasks 3 and 4 in the solicitation (P. 14-15) related to state/MPO plan reviews as well as traffic safety, pedestrian, and bicycle analysis, align with the review of 5310 and 5311 transit operators? MPO's were included in this solicitation to do audits if needed through a task order request.
- 3.) On page 14 of the solicitation, under the Task section, it states "consulting firm is encouraged to provide as much information as possible for each Task listed in their proposal, but each proposal must address Task 1 and 2".
 - Question: The solicitation states only 2 pages for the detailed summary, should the consulting firm only address Task 1 (Project Management) and Task 2 (On-Site and Review Period) in their proposal or address all four (4) tasks listed (i.e., Program Management, On-Site Visits and Review Periods, Plan Purpose, and Trends, Needs, and Issues)? Address all four tasks.
