Question	Answer	
1. A.2.1. Will a hard copy submission of the proposal package be required? If so, where should it be delivered to?	The proposal package should be sent in electronic form to <u>odotbids@odot.ok.gov</u> by the Response Due Date and time.	
2. A.2.4. Will a pdf format be acceptable for the electronic submission?	Yes	
3. A.26. Is Professional Liability insurance required? It is not listed. Can the coverage requirements be verified?	Vendors will need to just provide the insurance as required and state in A.26	
4. B.14.1. The scope of work does include collaboration and due diligence with other State DOT's, is no travel anticipated?	Any travel will be negotiated as part of the Task Order in accordance with state rates.	
5. Anticipated Schedule for RFP – Will the selection/award of the RFP come before negotiations or will the negotiations be apart of the selection process?	Negotiations could take place on 2 separate occasions. 1) ODOT could elect to conduct negotiations with the responders if requested or needed with regards to information in the response. 2) Once a vendor is selected, since this contract is task order based, negotiations over specifics of a task order could be held.
