I am writing in support of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation's (ODOT) grant application for the Competitive Highway Bridge Program. If awarded, this project will replace four bridges; three that are structurally deficient, and one that is at risk of becoming structurally deficient. All these projects are located near Dover, Oklahoma.

Two of the bridges are situated on US-81, while the other two are on public county roads in Kingfisher, OK. These bridges were constructed in the 1960's and have exceeded their useful life. Currently, the bridge decks are classified in serious and poor condition. The deterioration of these bridges poses a significant threat to the safety of residents, commercial vehicles, truck traffic, and emergency response units. This project will enhance the safety and efficiency of our transportation infrastructure. These projects are critical to the community and align with the goals of Federal Highway Administration's (FHWA).
