## ITEM TO BE PRESENTED BY THE DIRECTOR - Mr. Gatz

## 15. Director's Report - Information Only

Secretary Gatz began his report by thanking the Commission for their consideration during the Executive Session and expressed the pride in his duty to the State of Oklahoma, and the importance of support and partnerships.

Secretary Gatz continued his report by thanking the Commission for their support in the market study implementation and thanked Dawn Sullivan, Brian Taylor and ODOT's Human Resources Division for
their part in the implementation and review. Gatz informed the Commission of the last market study, done in January 2022, based on research and analysis from 2021. The current market study was prepared by Ernst \& Young, and a salary survey performed by American Association for State Transportation and Highway Officials (AASHTO) provided a good measure on the job market. Gatz continued by stating the market study implementation is not performance based, but strictly to keep pace with the market. The market minimum is $3 \%$, and the approximate maximum is $14 \%$.

In regard to federal funding, Secretary Gatz updated the Commission on the Continuing Resolution that will expire January $19^{\text {th }}$. It is believed that Congress has a budget agreement, and legislation will need to be passed, specifically in Transportation, Housing and Urban Development appropriations bill. Gatz is confident that full appropriations will be received for the current fiscal year and is encouraged with the progress made thus far.

Secretary Gatz announced the Department's first Electric Vehicle, manufactured by Canoo in Oklahoma City. The vehicle will go to Jared Schwennesen in Multimodal, who leads the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Investment Initiatives. The Department will use the vehicle as an opportunity to help advocate for a broader utilization of EVs across the state.

Secretary Gatz began his project updates by addressing the traveling public with a resurfacing and bridge replacement project on US-69 in Wagoner County. The project will be slightly disruptive to traffic with one lane reductions and is expected to be completed spring 2025.

Secretary Gatz continued the project updates with the bridge replacement project on US-287 in Cimarron County. Secretary Gatz thanked the traveling public for their patience during construction. Weather permitting, all lanes of the bridge can be open by the end of the month and upon that completion, pavement work will commence with an optimistic completion of summer 2024.

In another project update, Secretary Gatz updated the Commission on US-169 and I-244 bridge replacement in Tulsa that began in March 2023. Gatz added that northbound 169 to westbound I-244 remain narrowed to one lane, there will be some night and weekend closures as the old bridge is demolished. Completion date is expected to be Spring of this year. Gatz expressed the extreme importance of the connector in the Tulsa Metropolitan area and part of the Department's ongoing efforts to ensure the bridge infrastructure remains in good shape.

Secretary Gatz closed his report with winter weather safety. He addressed the traveling public in recommending the Drive Oklahoma app, have a safety kit prepared that includes extra cell phone batteries, food, water, extra blankets and to ensure vehicles are in good operating condition and to adjust speed accordingly with inclement weather. Gatz continued by stating ODOT is continuously prepared for inclement weather with 537 salt trucks statewide, approximately 1,500 personnel, 500 pieces of additional equipment if needed and salt/sand sheds are stocked up, ready for winter weather. The traveling public needs to be aware of salt trucks, and to stay back at least 300 feet. Gatz expressed how proud he is of ODOT personnel, who go above and beyond in service of the taxpayers of this state.

Commissioner Grimsley commended ODOT for their work on the Highway 39 shoulders and the safety of the corridor will improve immensely.

## SUBJECT: Wildcat Construction Co., Inc. Claim for Additional Payment

 Bridge Rehabilitation; Project No. SBR-400(146)SB; 33420(04)
## LOCATION: Canadian County; l-40 over South Maple Road, 3.0 miles west of US-270

This bridge rehabilitation contract was awarded by the Oklahoma Transportation Commission on May 2nd, 2022 to Wildcat Construction Co., Inc. for a total contract amount of $\$ 1,238,991.90$. Contract time was 120 calendar days.

In September of 2022, ODOT requested that a change order be executed to replace the parapet walls on both bridges. As a part of this change order, additional days were added to the contract for the extra work. This additional work resulted in the bridge deck overlays being pushed back approximately 2 months, which resulted in traffic remaining on the temporary transitions and existing shoulders for an extended period. Because of this, the existing shoulders experienced failures that resulted in damages to a select number of vehicles before repairs could be made.

The contractor has asked that they be compensated for these additional costs, stating that traffic would have been switched off the inadequate pavement had ODOT not requested the additional work. ODOT does not dispute this claim. The request includes $\$ 25,300.29$ for additional pothole repair and $\$ 8,459.13$ for vehicle damages, for a total of $\$ 33,759.42$. Due to this project exceeding the statutorily authorized $10 \%$ on new items, Commission approval is needed for the additional claim.

The entitlement for this claim is recognized by the Department, and it is recommended that the Commission authorize a settlement in the amount of $\$ 33,759.42$.

SUBJECT: Municipal Road Drilling Activity Fund - FY24

## LOCATION: <br> Off-System Statewide

The Municipal Road Drilling Activity Revolving Fund, 11 O.S.§ 37-501, was signed into law in 2022. This legislation provides funding assistance to municipalities with populations less than 15,000 who have experienced roadway damage due to increased oilfield activities. After reviewing requests for participation in funding, the Department recommends award of Municipal Road Drilling Activity Funds totaling $\$ 5,220,000.00$. This award will assist eleven cities to repair or replace 18.96 miles of municipal roadways.
