Individual Assistance



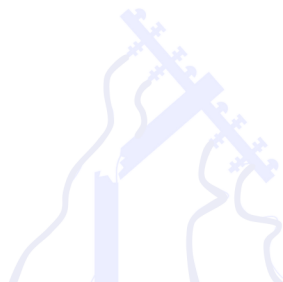
- Damage assessments completed in **18** counties revealed at least **827** homes and businesses damaged
- FEMA Individual Assistance approved in **13** counties:

Carter, Hughes, Kay, Lincoln, Love, Murray, Okfuskee, Okmulgee, Osage, Pontotoc, Pottawatomie, Washington, and Washita

- **2,076** households have registered for FEMA assistance
- **483** people have visited Disaster Recovery Centers (**3** are open)
- **\$4,587,011** in FEMA and State funds has been paid to survivors for housing and other needs
- **\$2,101,300** in SBA Low Interest Disaster Loans have been approved for **27** residents and **1** business owner



Public Assistance



- Public Assistance refers to costs related to public infrastructure, debris, utilities, and emergency response
- Damage assessments completed in **22** counties revealed at least **\$16.3 million** in damages

- FEMA Public Assistance approved for **17** counties:

Carter, Coal, Cotton, Haskell, Hughes, Johnston, Kay, Love, Murray, Okfuskee, Okmulgee, Osage, Pittsburg, Pontotoc, Tillman, Washington, and Washita
