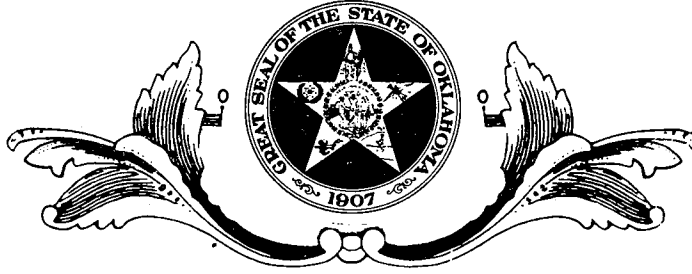

Proclamation

Whereas, the climate of the State of Oklahoma is conducive to the development of Winter Weather Precipitation; and

Whereas, the citizens of the State of Oklahoma are adversely affected by such weather conditions; and

Whereas, it is recognized that where appropriate actions are taken in response to such conditions, fewer persons are injured or killed; and

Whereas, it is vital that we further an awareness of the dangers of such weather conditions and the protective measures citizens can take in the event of such conditions; and

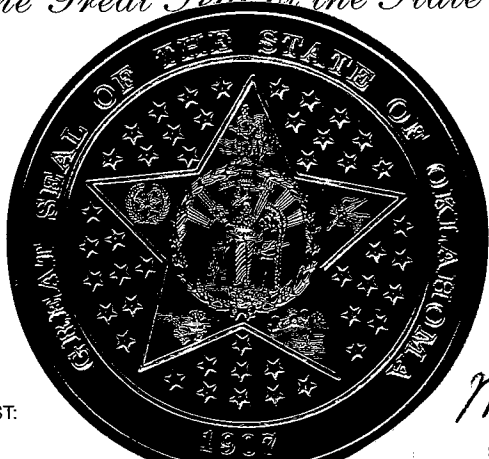
Whereas, the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management, Oklahoma Department of Transportation, National Weather Service, other state agencies and local governments desire to continue working with the citizens of Oklahoma and the news media to disseminate Winter Weather preparedness information to the people of the State;

Now, therefore, I, Brad Henry, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim November 10, 2010, as

“Winter Weather Preparedness Day”

in the State of Oklahoma, and urge the cooperation of the above named federal, state, and local agencies, together with the news media of the State, in a concerted effort to inform the citizenry of proper actions to take when winter weather conditions prevail.
