

### WILDFIRE PREPAREDNESS

## WILDFIRES ARE OFTEN CAUSED BY HUMAN ACTIVITY

High winds and dry conditions can set the stage for potentially severe fires.



Be careful when pulling off a road or driving into a field

Keep a fire extinguisher & water handy when working outdoors with equipment that gets hot or involves sparks





Avoid burning trash

Do not use fireworks during holidays





Extinguish cigarettes in vehicle ashtrays

# IF ADVISED TO EVACUATE, DO SO IMMEDIATELY.

Choose a route away from the fire hazard & be alert to changes in the speed & direction of fire & smoke

## PREPARE BY TAKING THE FOLLOWING PRECAUTIONS




Place connected garden hoses on all sides of the house for emergency use

Know all emergency


exits from your house

Learn all routes out of your neighborhood




#### AS FIRES APPROACH



Park your car facing the direction of escape

Place combustible patio furniture inside



Shut off gas at the meter\*\*



\*\*Only a qualified professional can safely turn the gas back on

Turn off propane tanks
