OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – January 2019

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Unemployment rates down over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in January

In January, **McIntosh County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.9 percent. **McCurtain County** and **Latimer County** were tied for the second-highest rate for the month. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.9 percent. Unemployment rates in January were lower than a year earlier in 64 counties, higher in six counties and unchanged in seven counties.

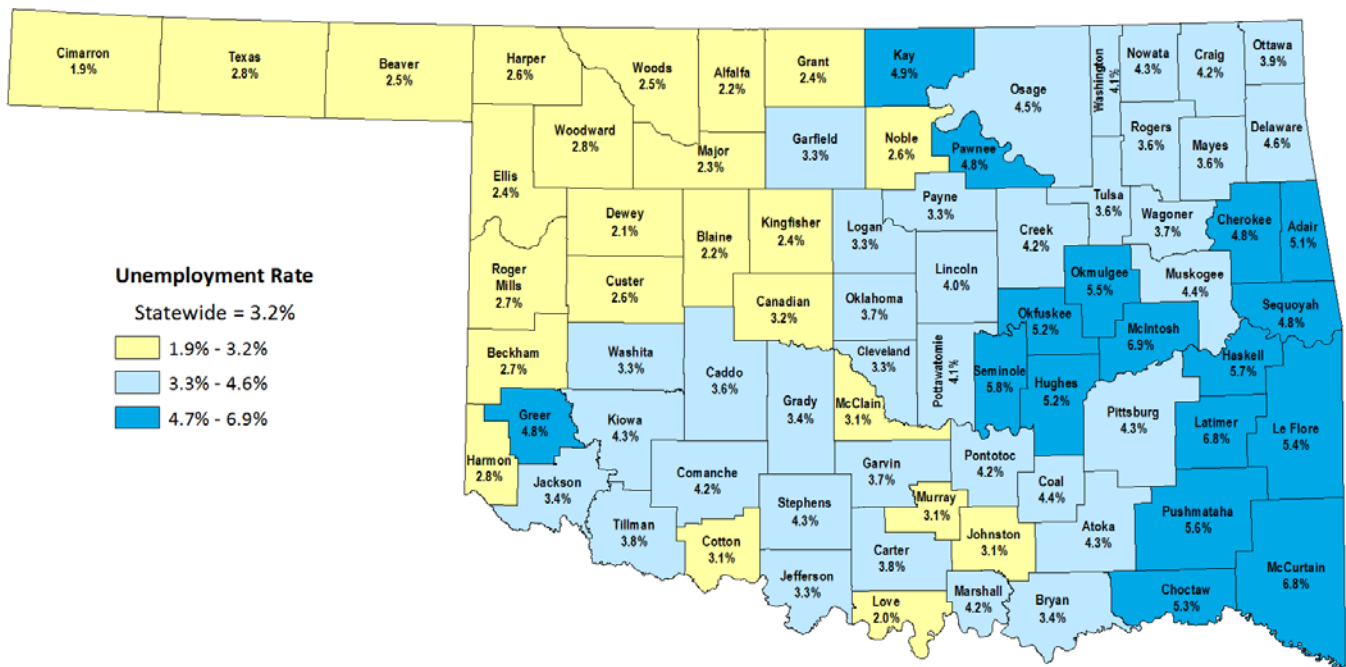

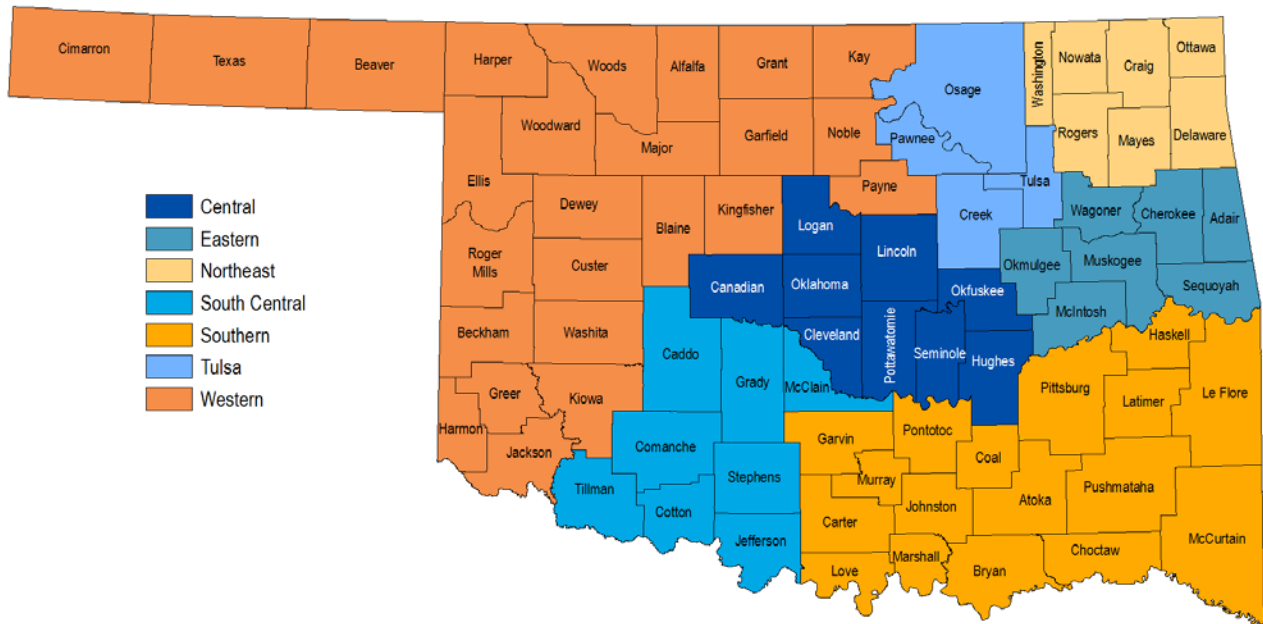
