OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – March 2019

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Unemployment rates down over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in March

In March, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 5.7 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **McCurtain County** had the state's third highest rate. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.7 percent. Unemployment rates in March were lower than a year earlier in 74 counties and higher in three counties.

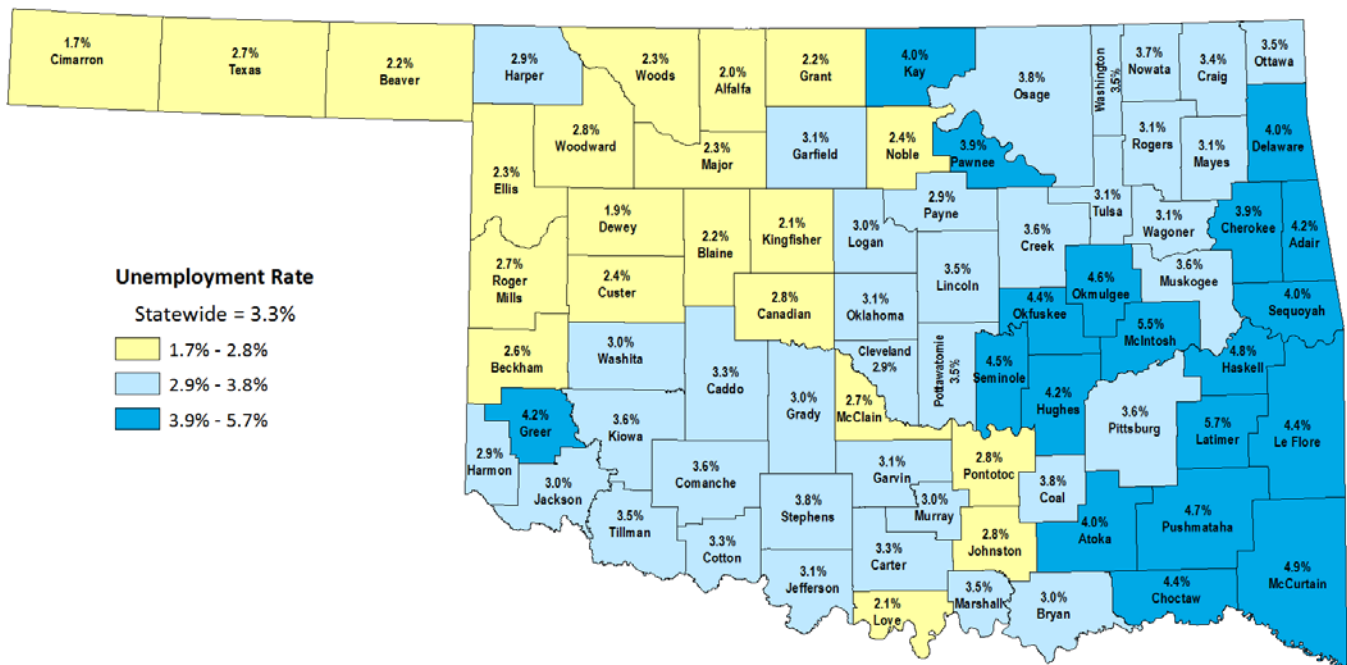

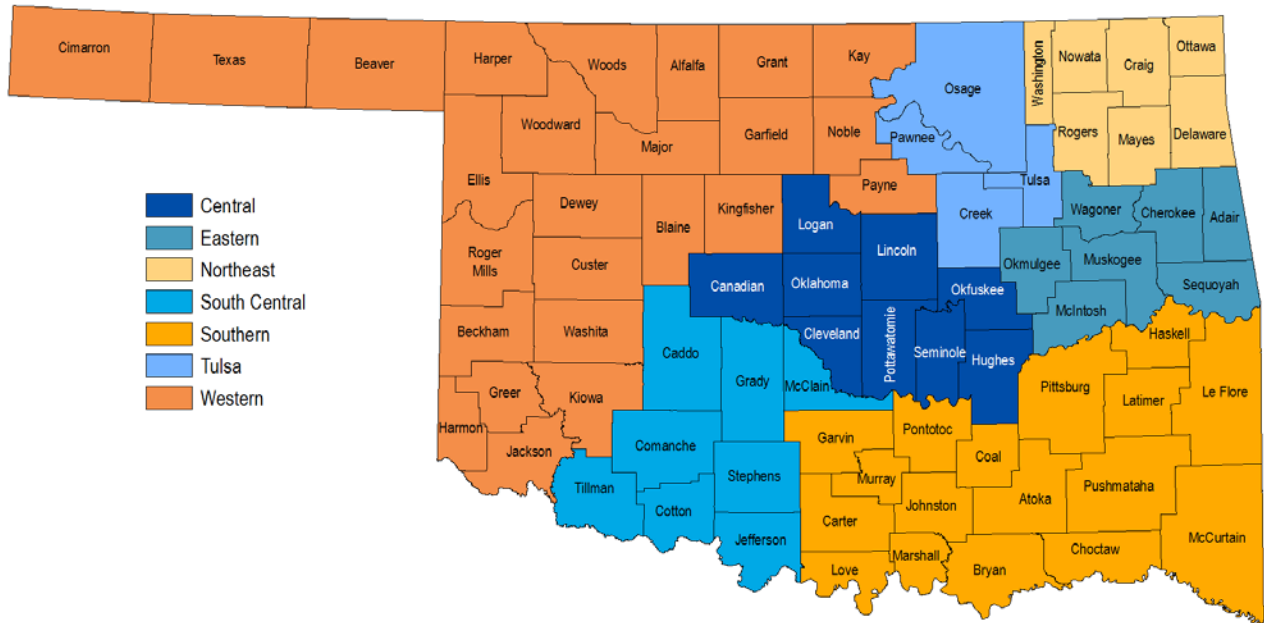
