OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – April 2019

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Unemployment rates down over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in April

In April, **Latimer County** and **McIntosh County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 4.6 percent. **McCurtain County** and **Okmulgee County** had the second highest rate for the month. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.4 percent. Unemployment rates in April were lower than a year earlier in 75 counties and higher in two counties.

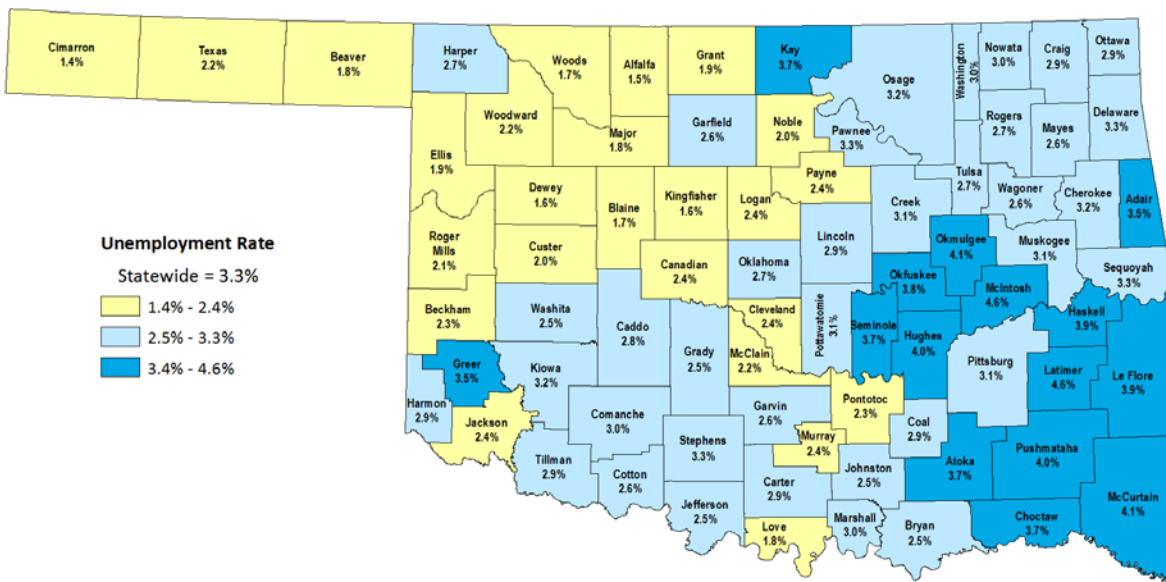
