OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – June 2019 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in June

In June, **Latimer County and McIntosh County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.2 percent. **McCurtain County** had the second-highest rate for the month. **Alfalfa County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.9 percent in June. Unemployment rates in June were lower than a year earlier in 70 counties, higher in five counties and unchanged in two counties.

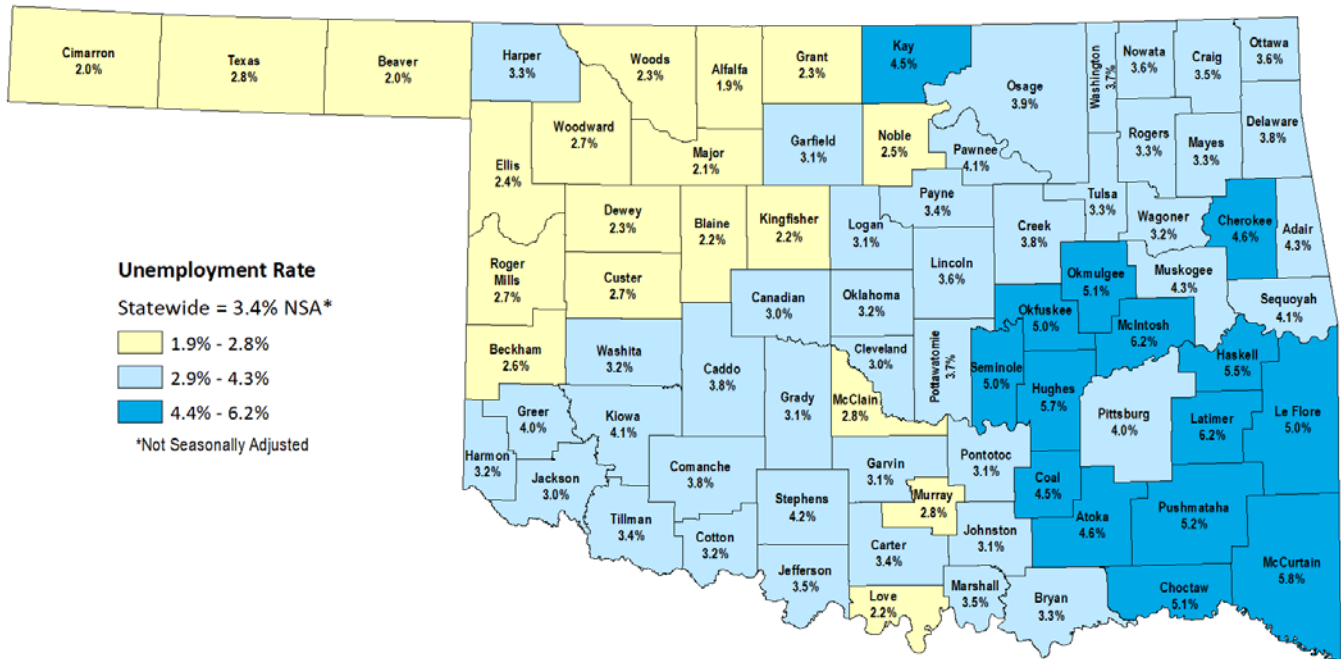

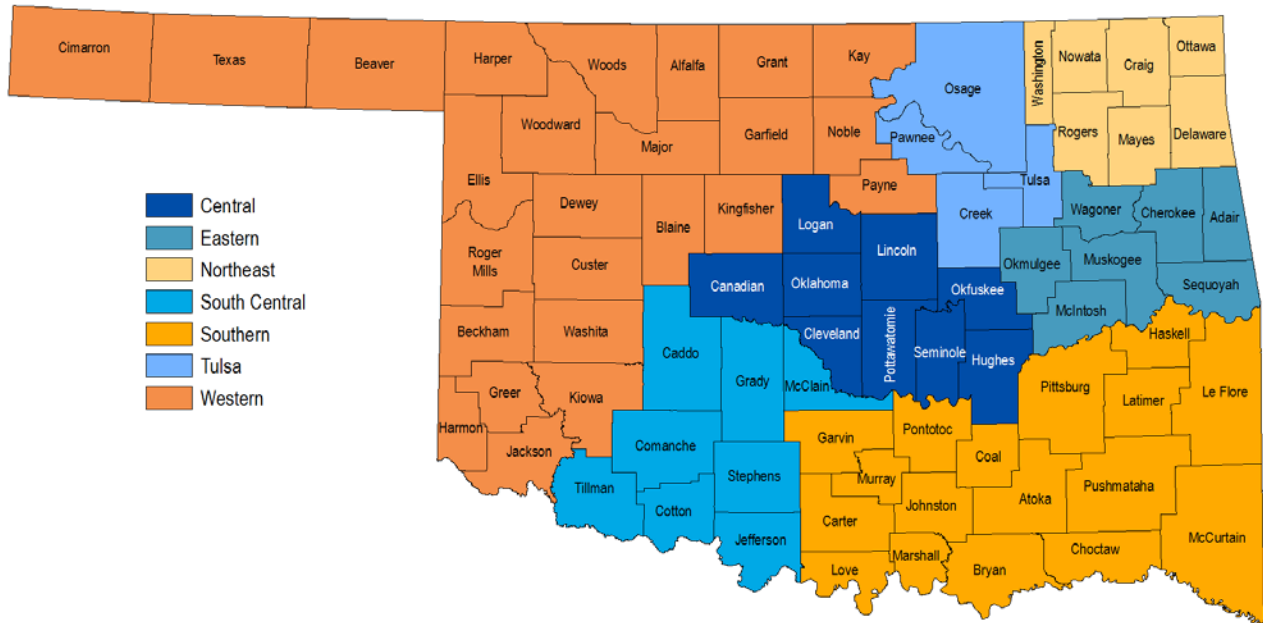
