OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – July 2019 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates move up over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in July

In July, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.6 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second-highest rate for the month. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.0 percent in July. Unemployment rates in July were higher than a year earlier in 49 counties, lower in 16 counties and unchanged in 12 counties.

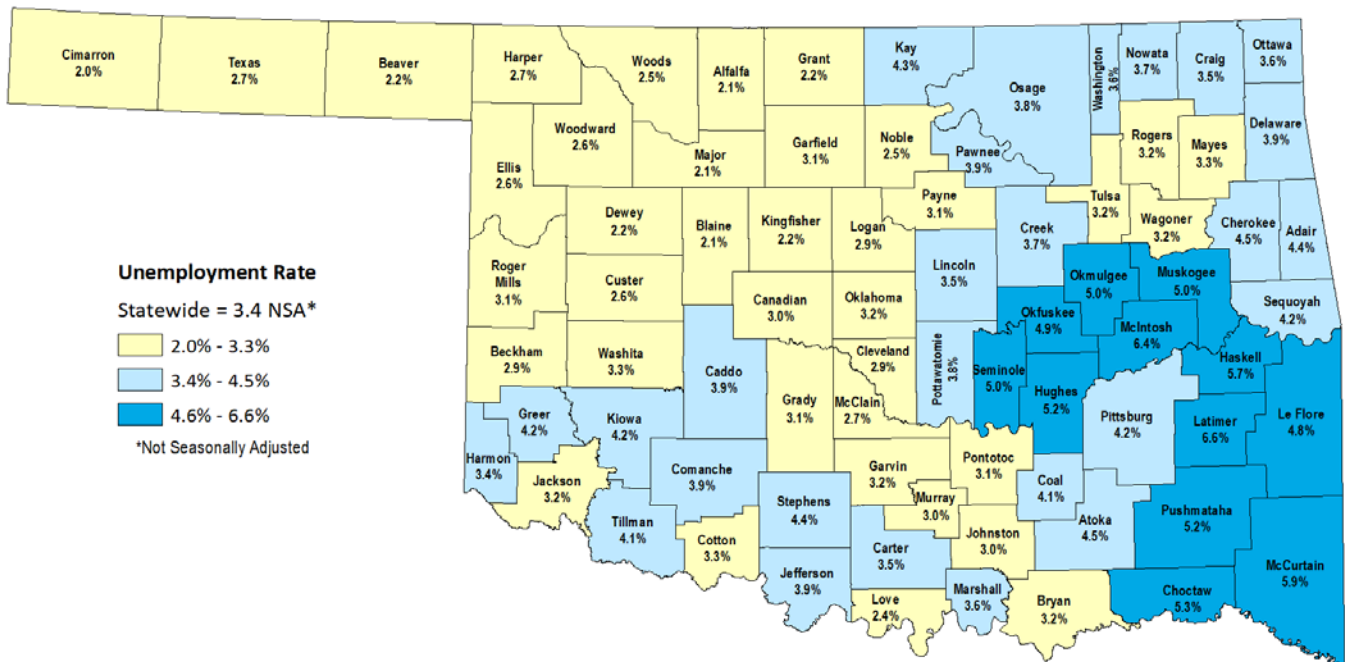

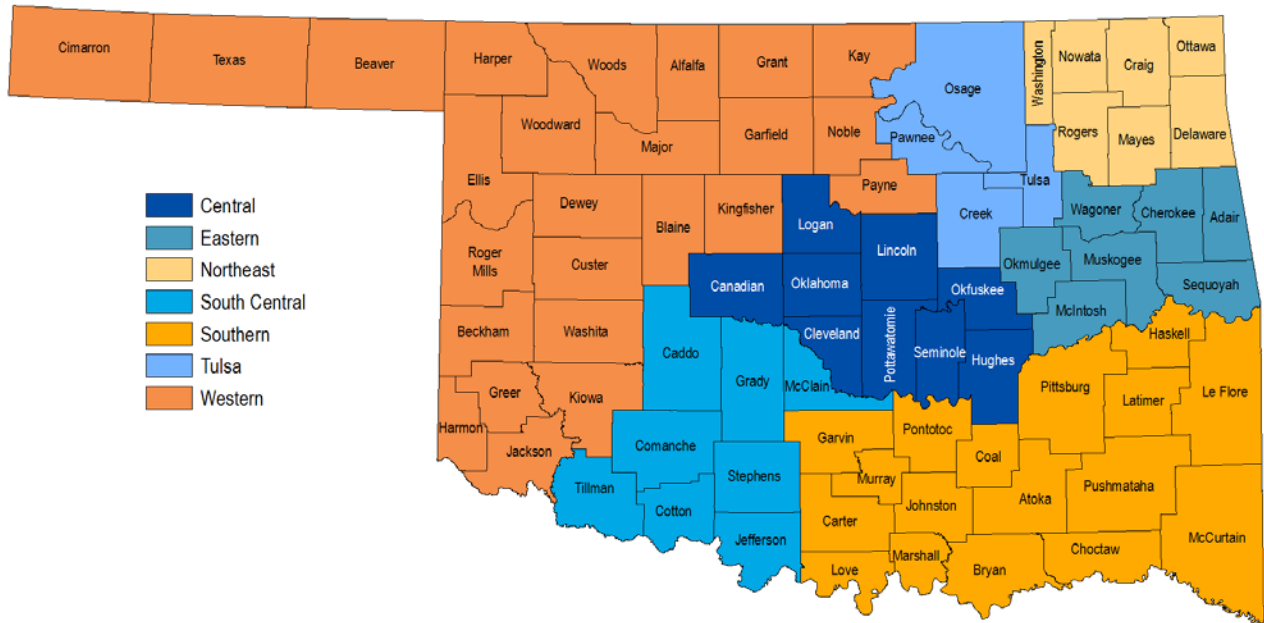
