## OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – September 2019

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

### Jobless rates up over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in September

In September, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.1 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second-highest rate for the month. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.7 percent in September. Unemployment rates in September were higher than a year earlier in 63 counties, lower in seven counties and unchanged in seven counties.

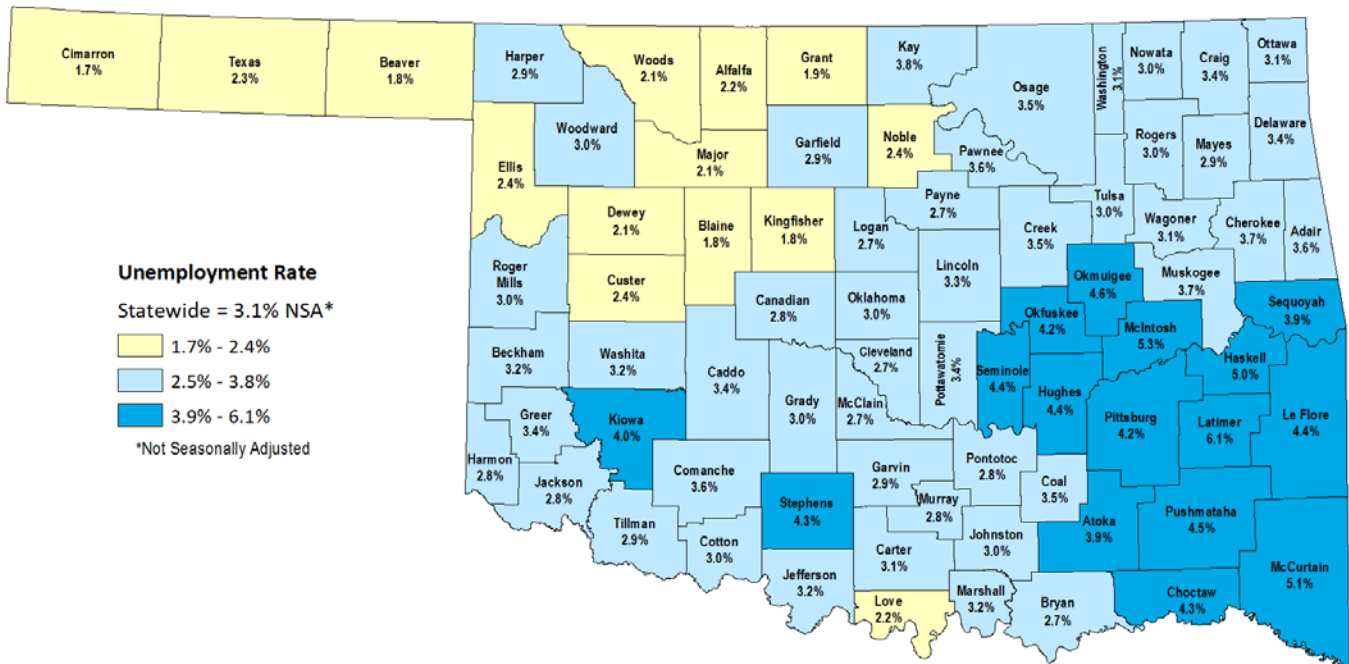

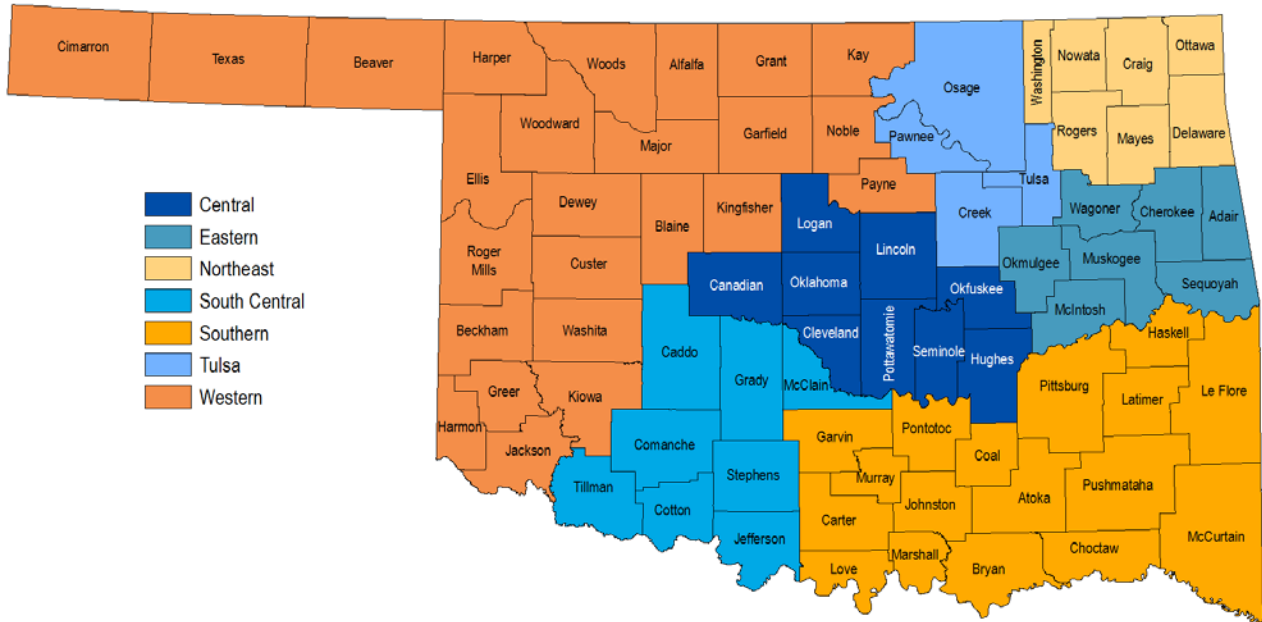
