OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – October 2019

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates move up over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in October

In October, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 7.3 percent. **Haskell County** had the second-highest rate for the month. **Beaver** and **Cimarron Counties** shared the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.6 percent in October. Unemployment rates in October were higher than a year earlier in 57 counties, lower in 14 counties and unchanged in six counties.

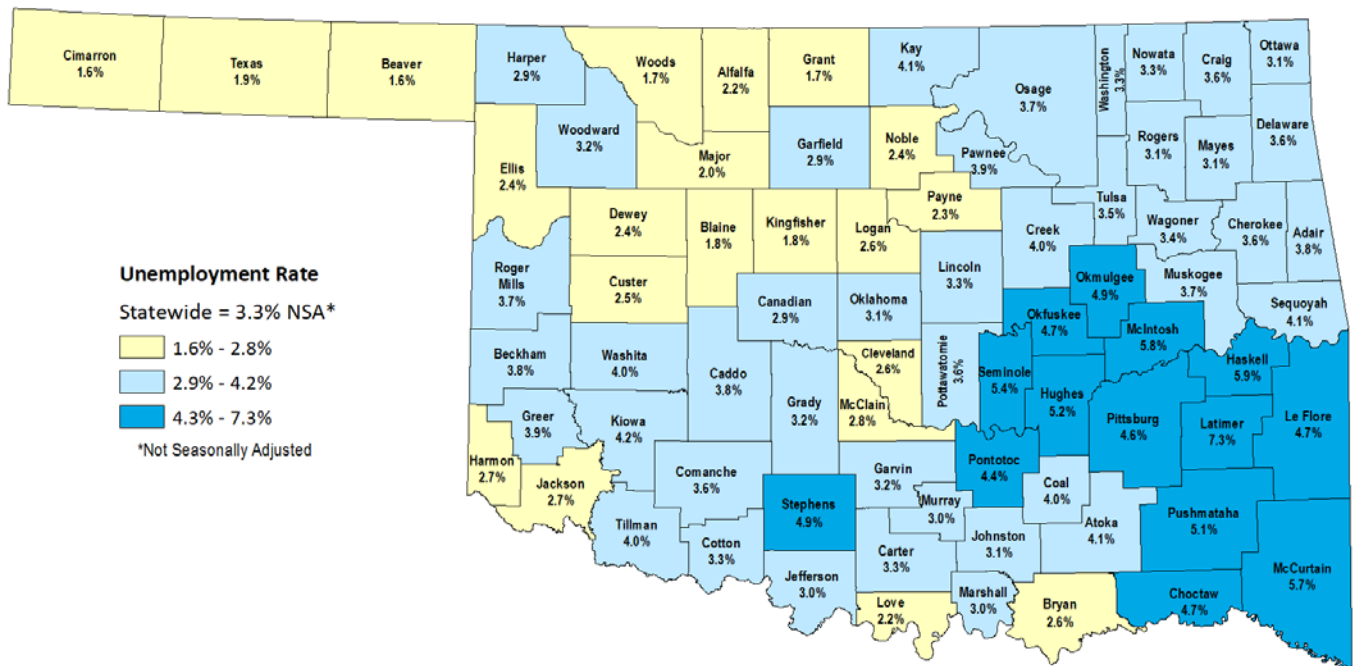

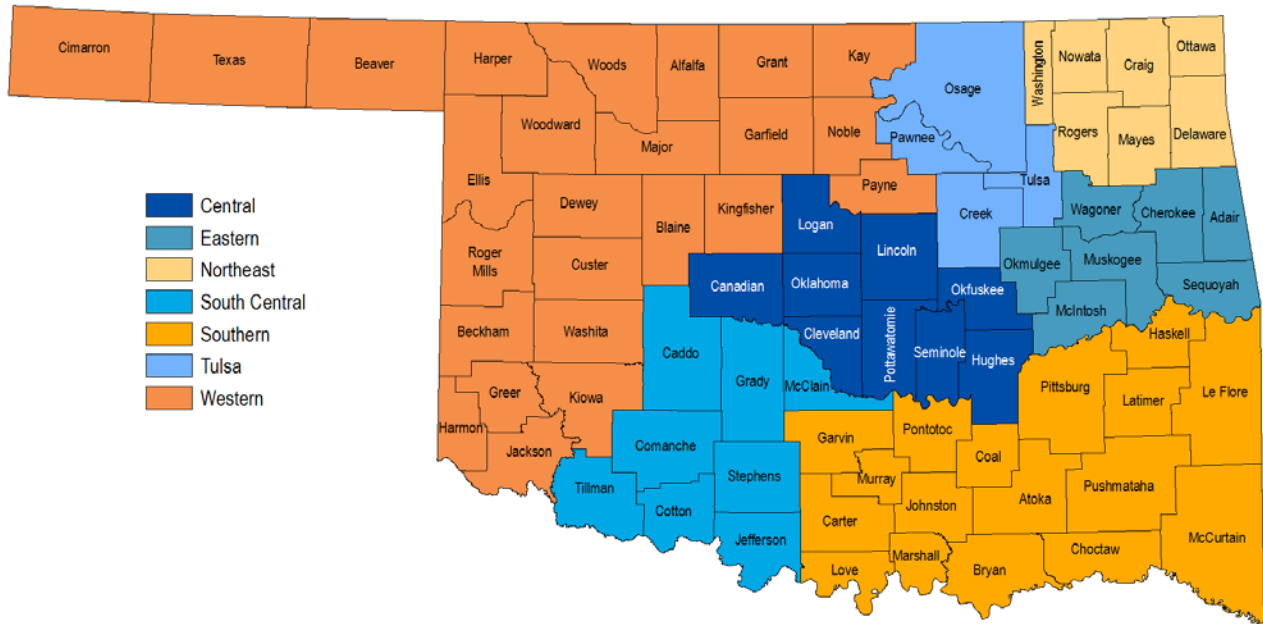
