OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – November 2019

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates move up over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in November

In November, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 7.7 percent. **Haskell** and **McIntosh Counties** shared the second-highest rate for the month. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.8 percent in November. Unemployment rates in November were higher than a year earlier in 75 counties, lower in one county and unchanged in one county.

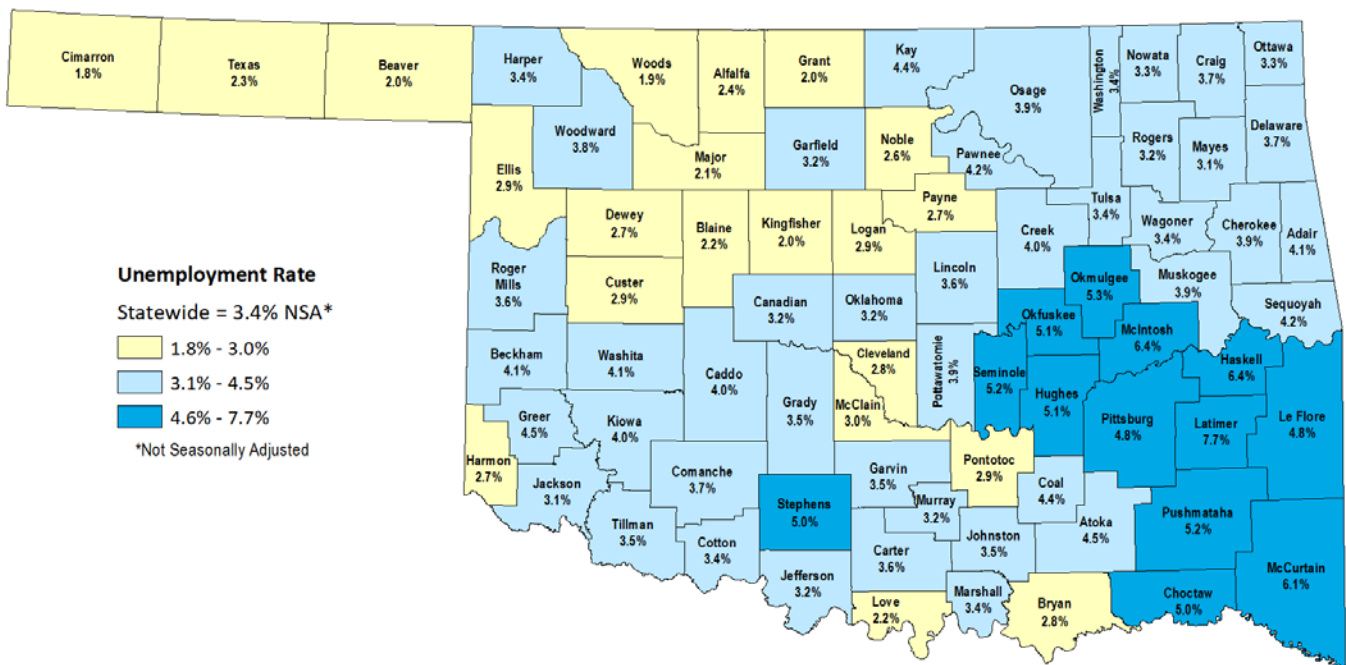
