OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – December 2019

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates move up over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in December

In December, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 7.2 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **McCurtain County**. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.6 percent in December. Unemployment rates in December were higher than a year earlier in 53 counties, lower in 13 counties and unchanged in 11 counties.

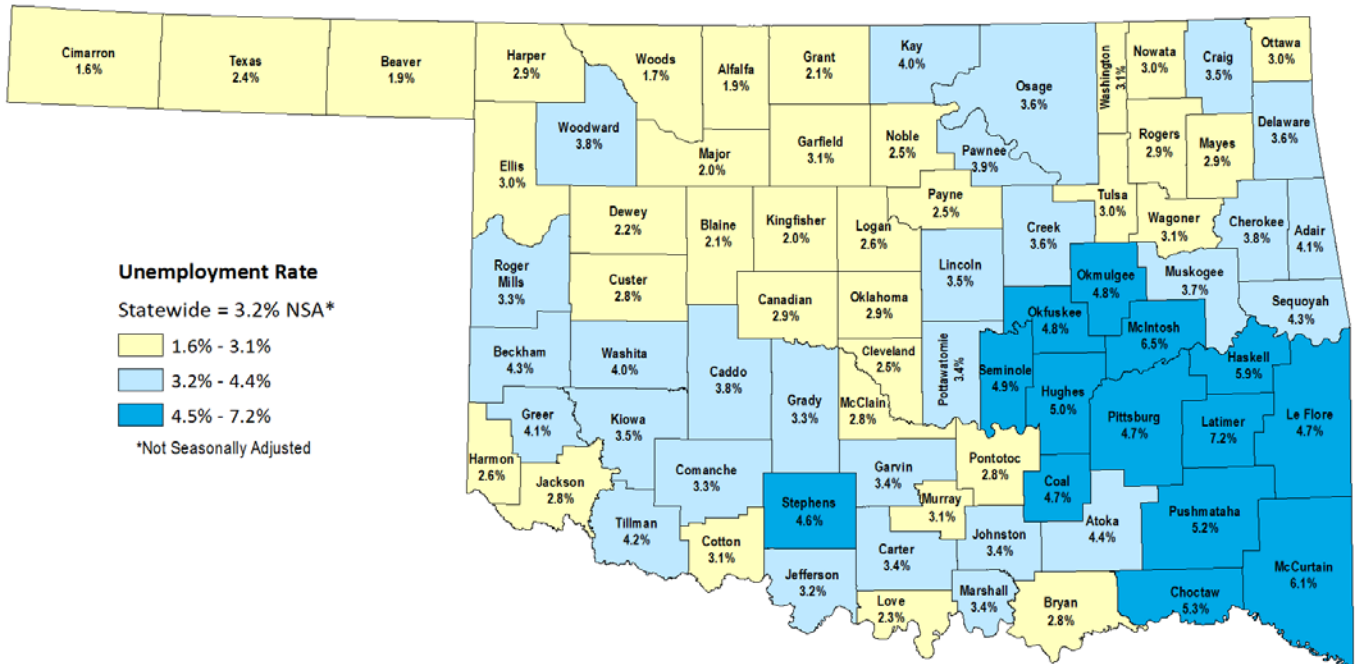

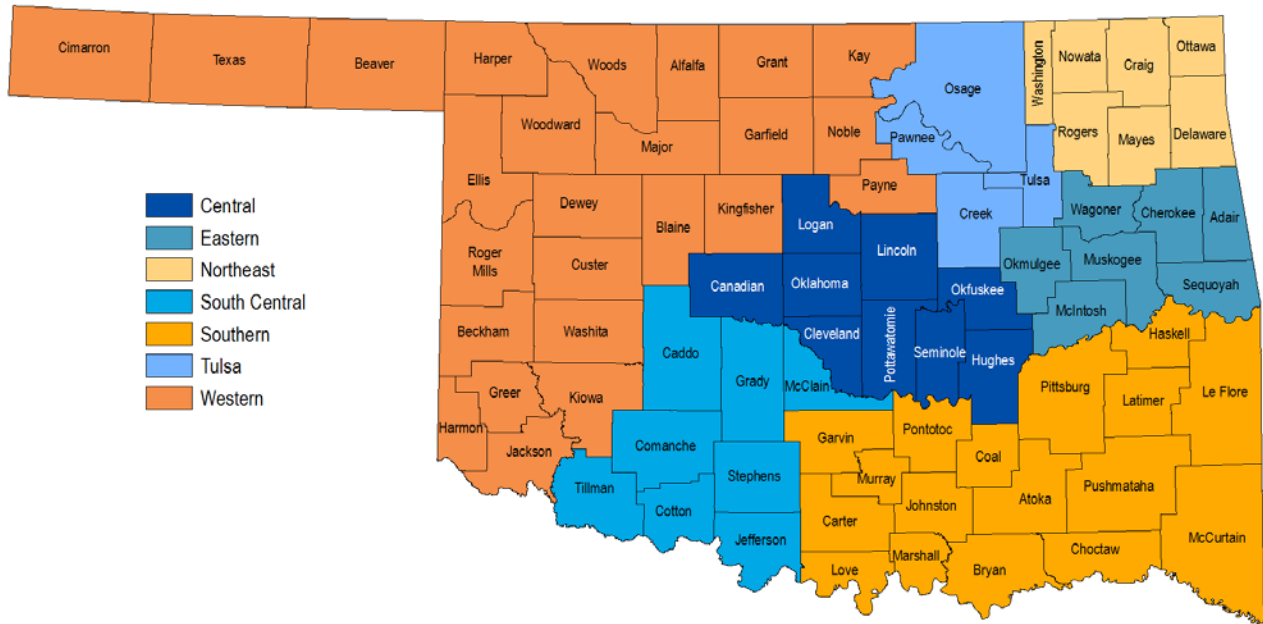
