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OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - July 2019

Oklahoma's unemployment rate unchanged in July

Oklahoma's seasonally adjusted **unemployment rate** was unchanged at 3.2 percent in July, while the U.S. unemployment rate held steady at 3.7 percent in July. The state's seasonally adjusted **unemployment rate** was also unchanged compared to July 2018.

In July, statewide seasonally adjusted **employment** increased by 6,310 persons (0.4 percent), while **unemployment** increased by 209 persons (0.4 percent). Over the year, seasonally adjusted **unemployment** fell by 628 persons (-1.1 percent).

Oklahoma nonfarm employment adds jobs in July

Oklahoma's seasonally adjusted **NONFARM EMPLOYMENT** added 4,100 jobs (0.2 percent) in July 2019. U.S. seasonally adjusted **NONFARM EMPLOYMENT** added 164,000 jobs (0.1 percent) in July. Over the year, state **NONFARM EMPLOYMENT** gained 14,500 jobs (0.9 percent).

- In July, eight of Oklahoma's supersectors added jobs as Education and Health Services (+1,000 jobs)
 posted the largest monthly gain followed by Professional and Business Services and Government (+900
 jobs each).
- Financial Activities (-400 jobs) reported the largest over-the-month job losses.
- Construction (+6,100 jobs) claimed the largest job gain over the year, followed by Education and Health Services (+4,600 jobs), and Other Services (+3,300 jobs).
- Sectors showing large declines in jobs over the year were **Manufacturing** (-1,700 jobs) and **Information** (-1,400 jobs).
