OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – February 2020

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in February

In February, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 7.2 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Haskell County**. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.5 percent in February. Unemployment rates in February were lower than a year earlier in 54 counties, higher in 19 counties and unchanged in 4 counties.

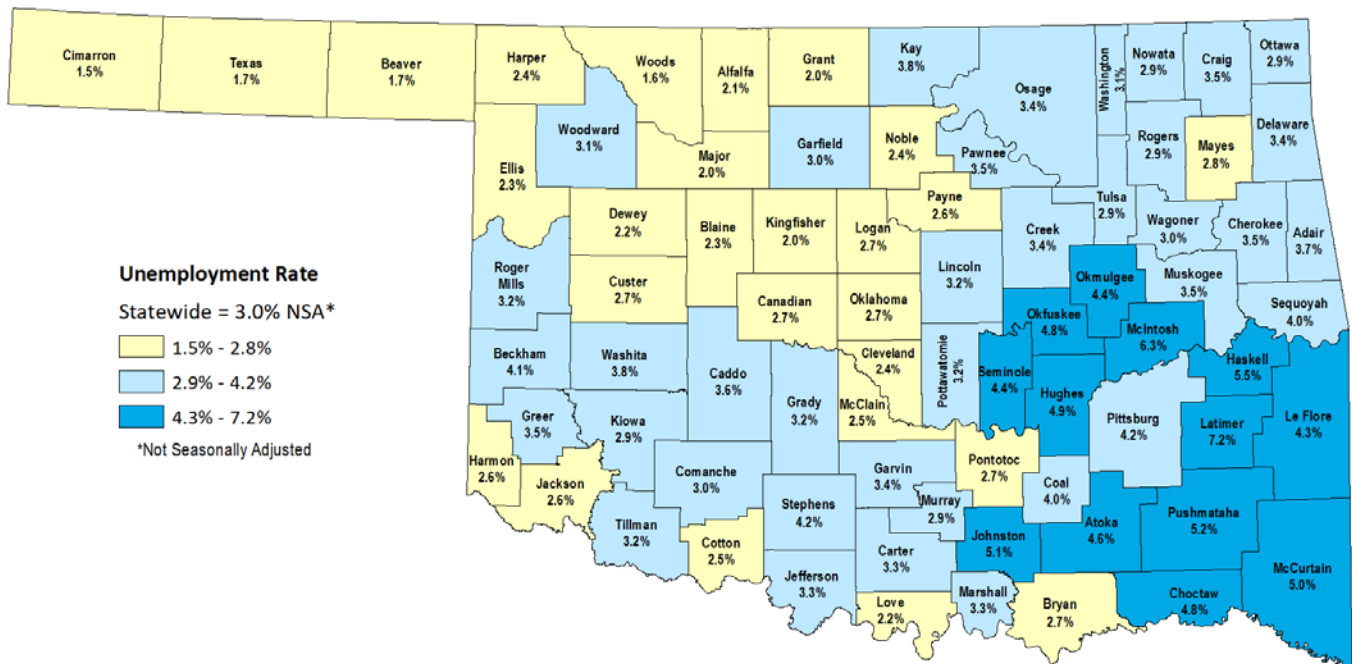

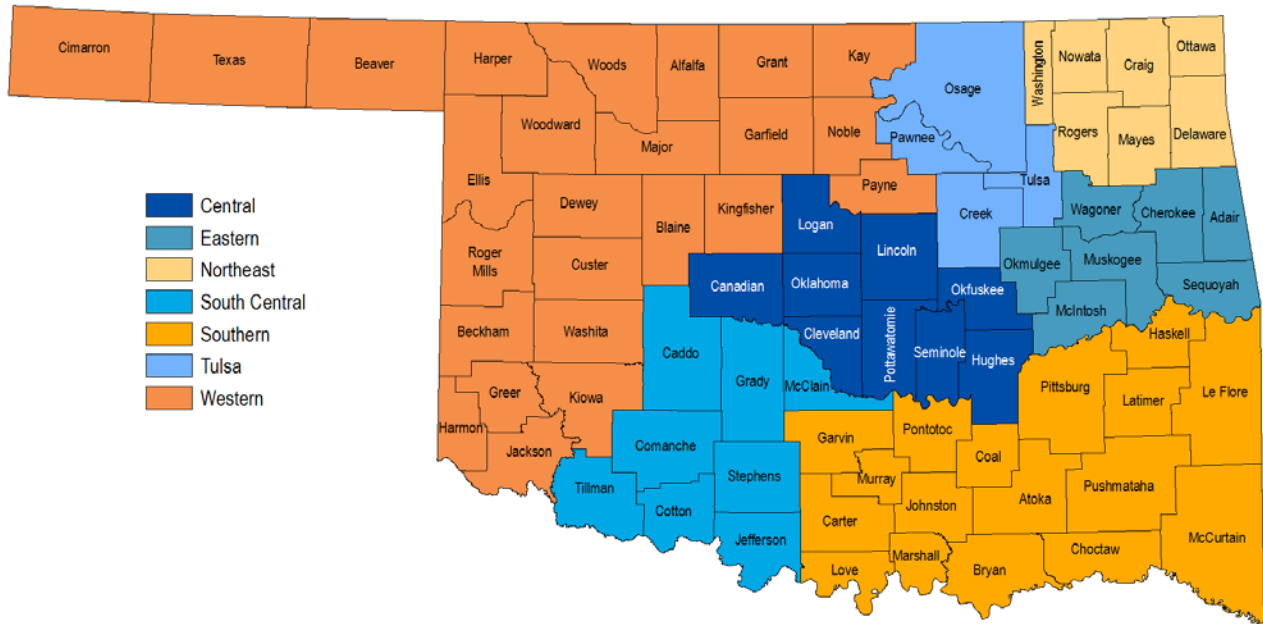
