OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – March 2020

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in March

In March, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.3 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Haskell County**. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.5 percent in March. Unemployment rates in March were lower than a year earlier in 61 counties, higher in 15 counties and unchanged in 1 county.

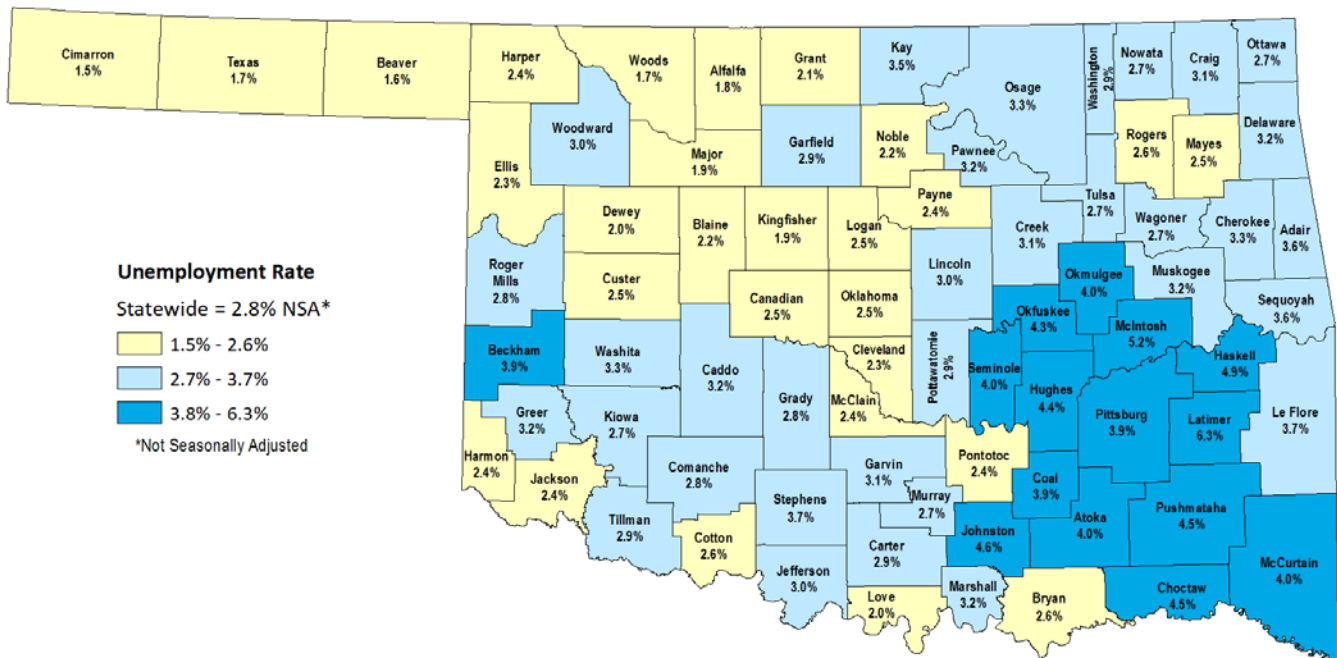
