OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – April 2020 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates climb over the year in every county in Oklahoma in April

In April, **Tillman County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 19.7 percent. **Johnston County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Comanche County**. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.6 percent in April. Unemployment rates in April were higher than a year earlier in all 77 counties.

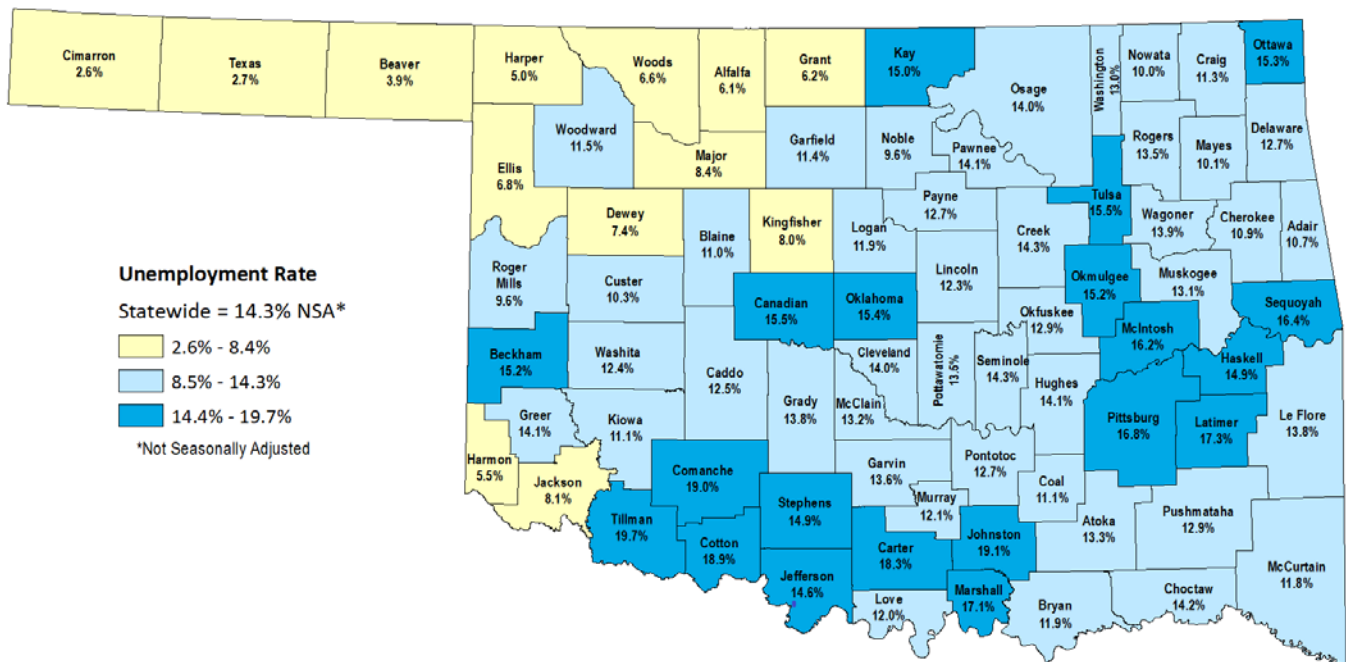

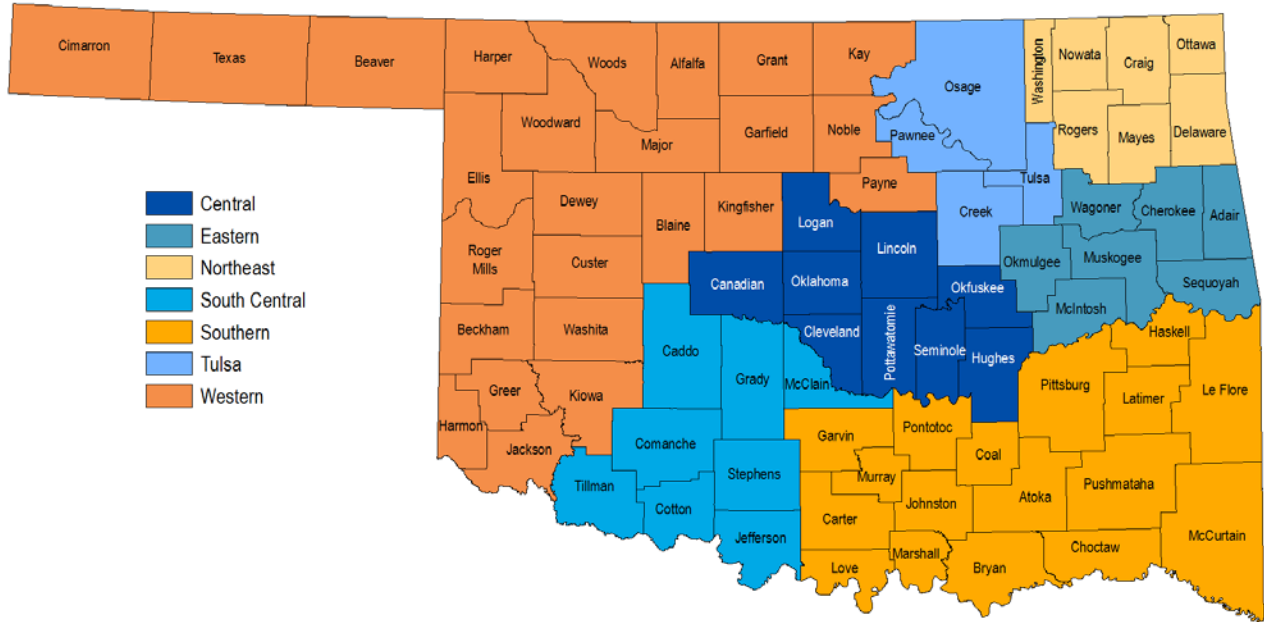
