OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – May 2020 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates climb in every county in Oklahoma in May

In May, **Tillman County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 18.8 percent. **Johnston County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Cotton County**. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 3.0 percent in May. Unemployment rates in May were higher than a year earlier in all 77 counties.

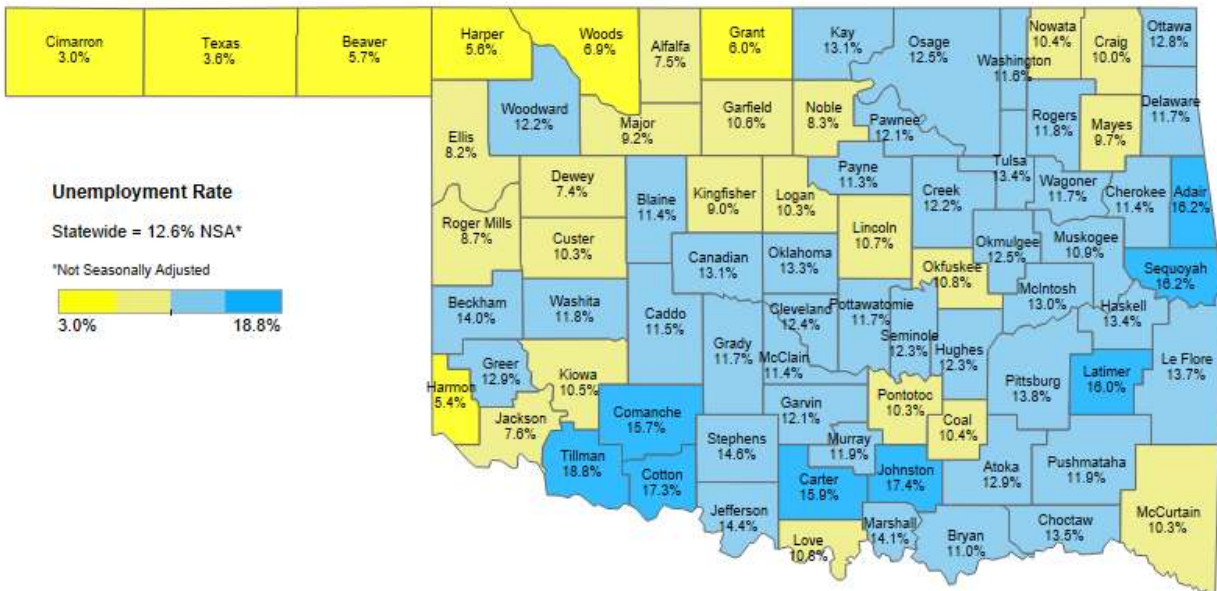
