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OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – September 2020

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates improve in all counties in Oklahoma in September

In September, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 9.2 percent. **Beckham County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Johnston and Stephens Counties**. **Cimarron County** posted the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.4 percent in September. Unemployment rates in September were higher than a year earlier in 73 of Oklahoma’s 77 counties, lower in 2 counties and unchanged in 2 counties.

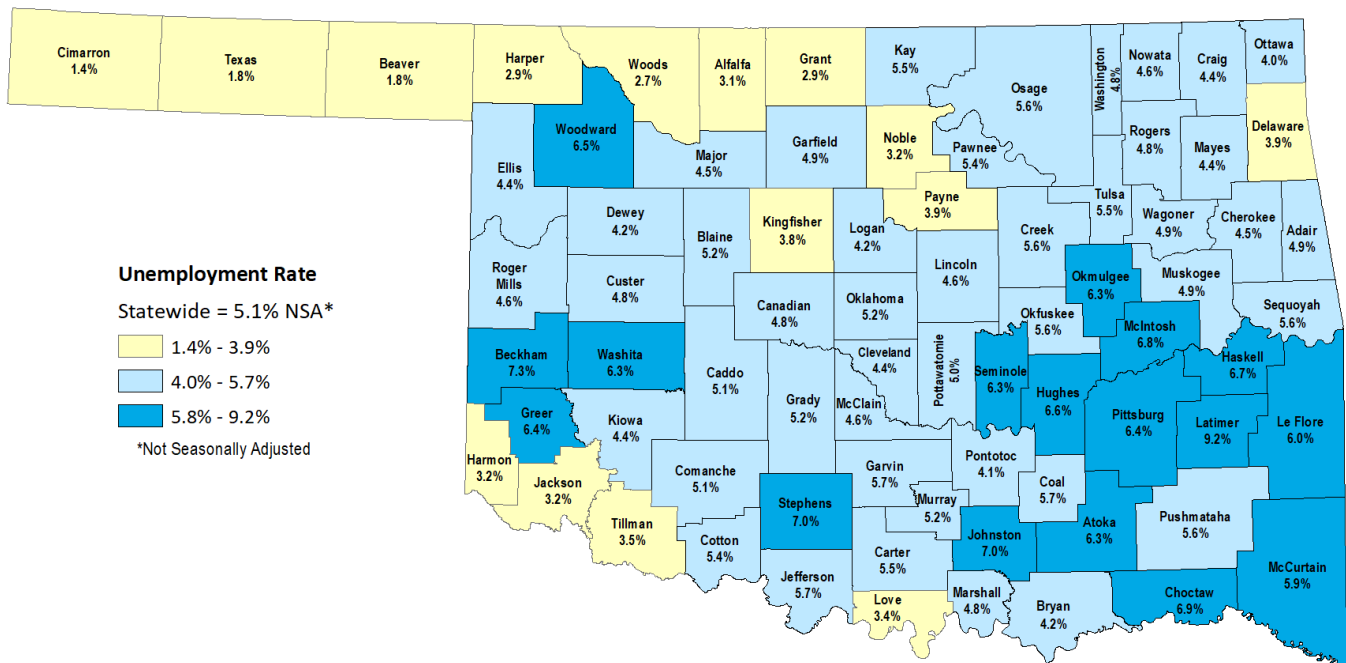

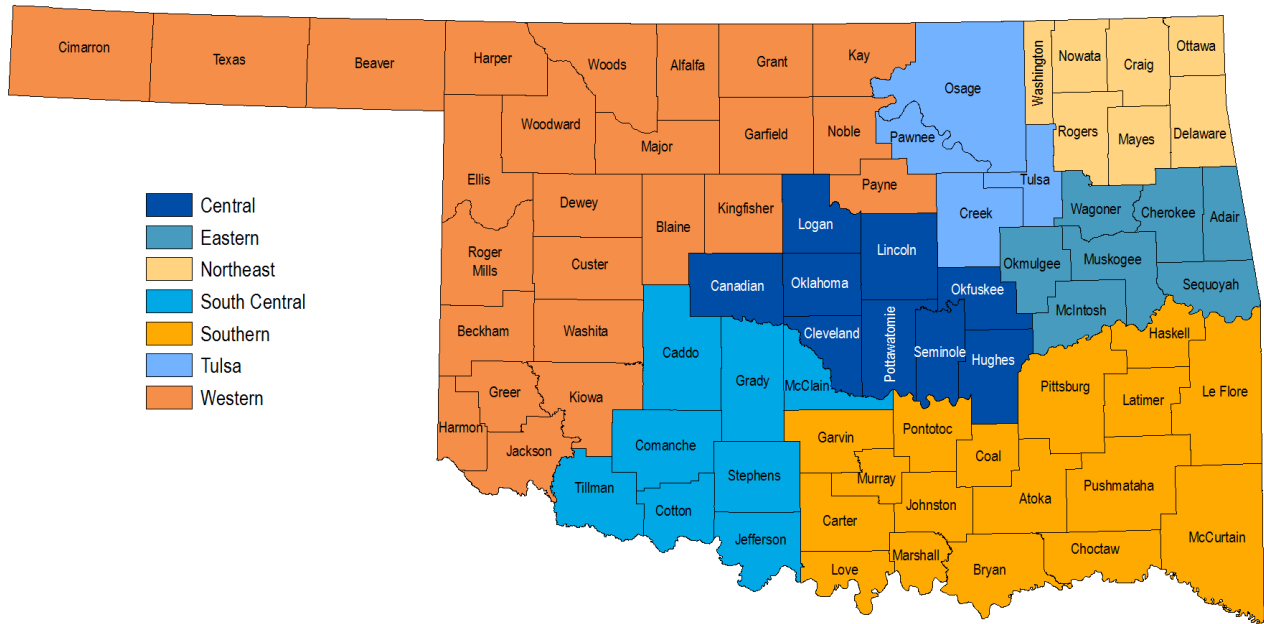
