

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – October 2020

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates increase in all counties in Oklahoma in October

In October, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 11.2 percent. **Beckham County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **McIntosh County**. **Cimarron County** posted the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.0 percent in October. Unemployment rates in October were higher than a year earlier in 76 of Oklahoma’s 77 counties and lower in one county.

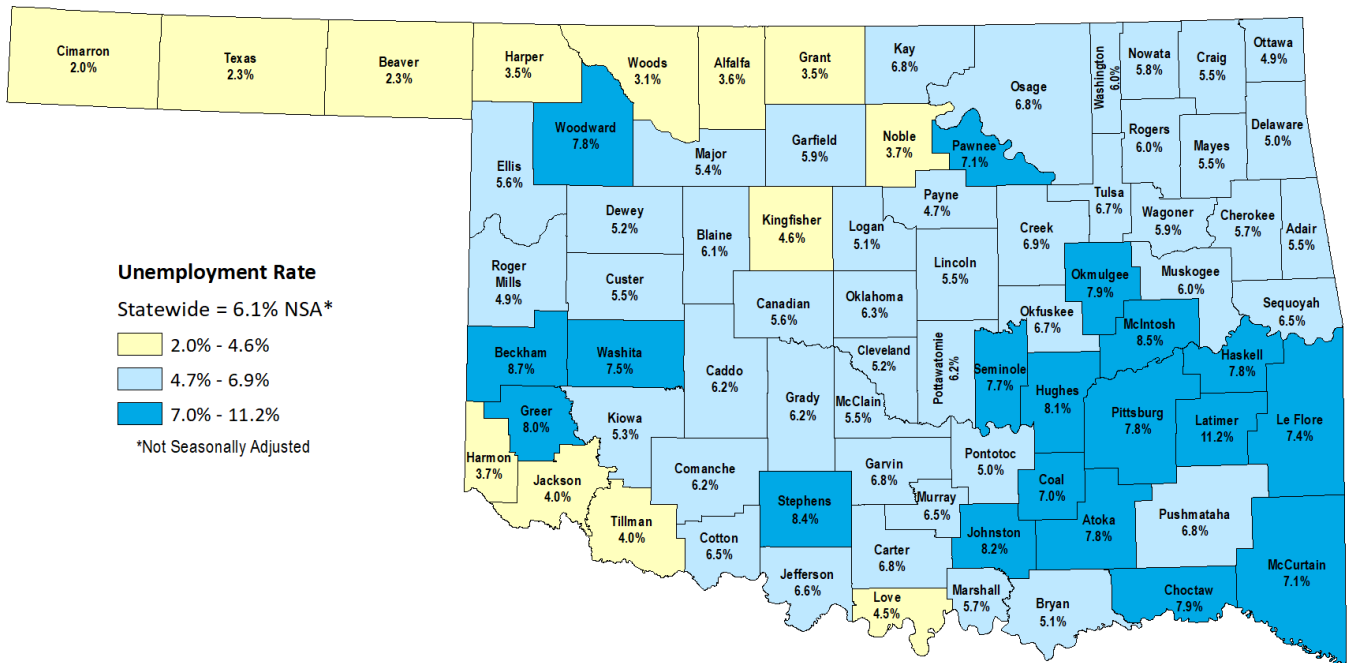
