

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – November 2020

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the month in most counties in Oklahoma in November

In November, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 10.8 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Johnston County**. **Cimarron County** posted the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.8 percent in November. Unemployment rates in November were higher than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma’s 77 counties.

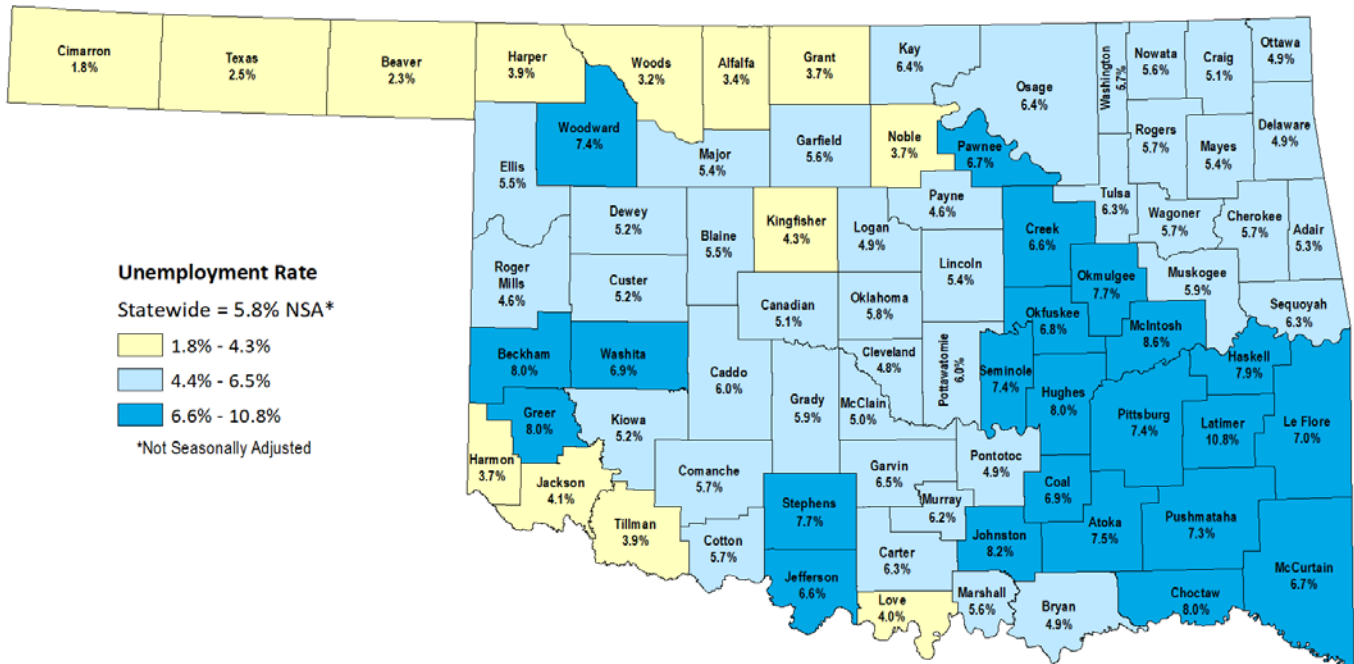

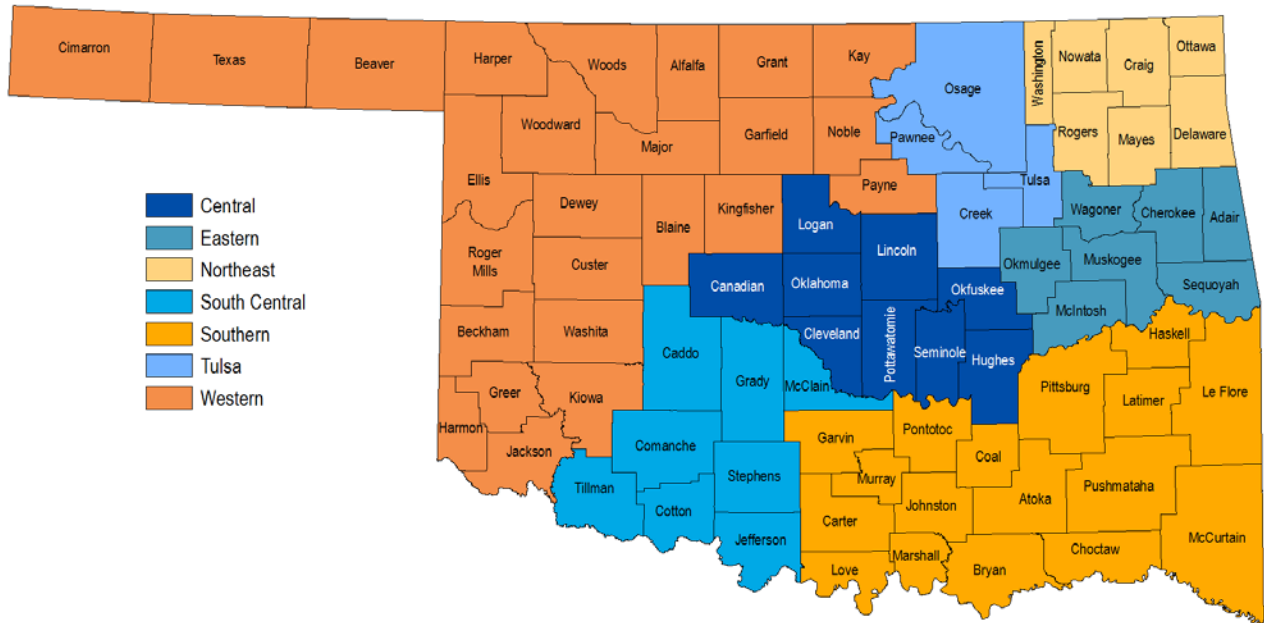
