

# OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – May 2021

## Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

### Jobless rates up over the month for most Oklahoma counties in May

In May, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 6.7 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Choctaw County**. **Beaver** and **Cimarron Counties** shared the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.6 percent in May. Unemployment rates in May were lower than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma’s 77 counties.

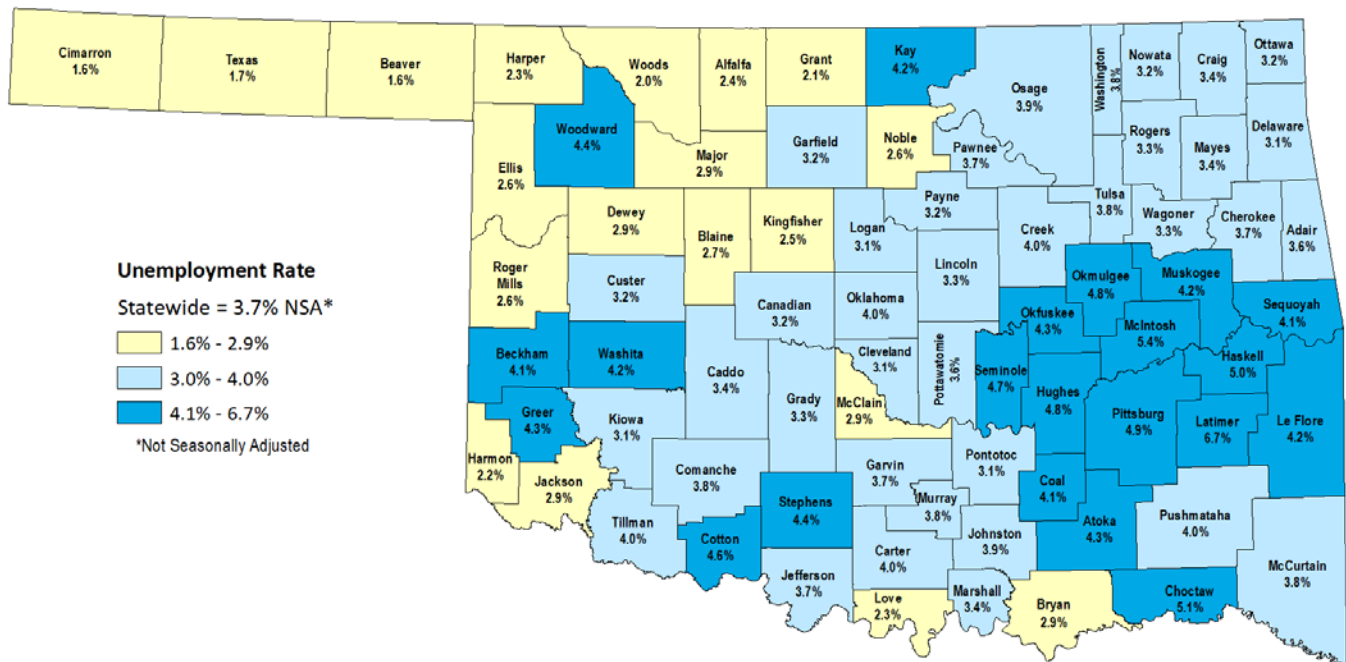
