

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – June 2021

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates up over the month for most Oklahoma counties in June

In June, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 7.4 percent. **Haskell** and **McIntosh Counties** shared the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Pittsburg County**. **Cimarron County** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.3 percent in June. Unemployment rates in June were lower than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma’s 77 counties.

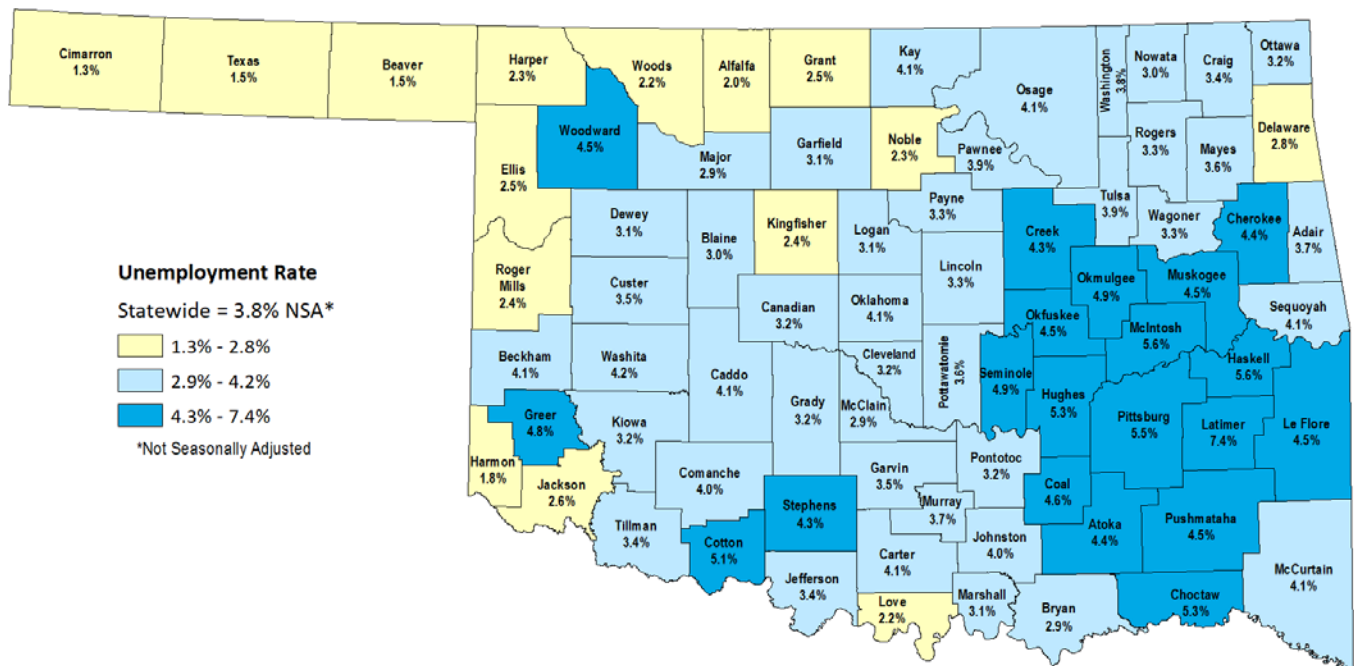

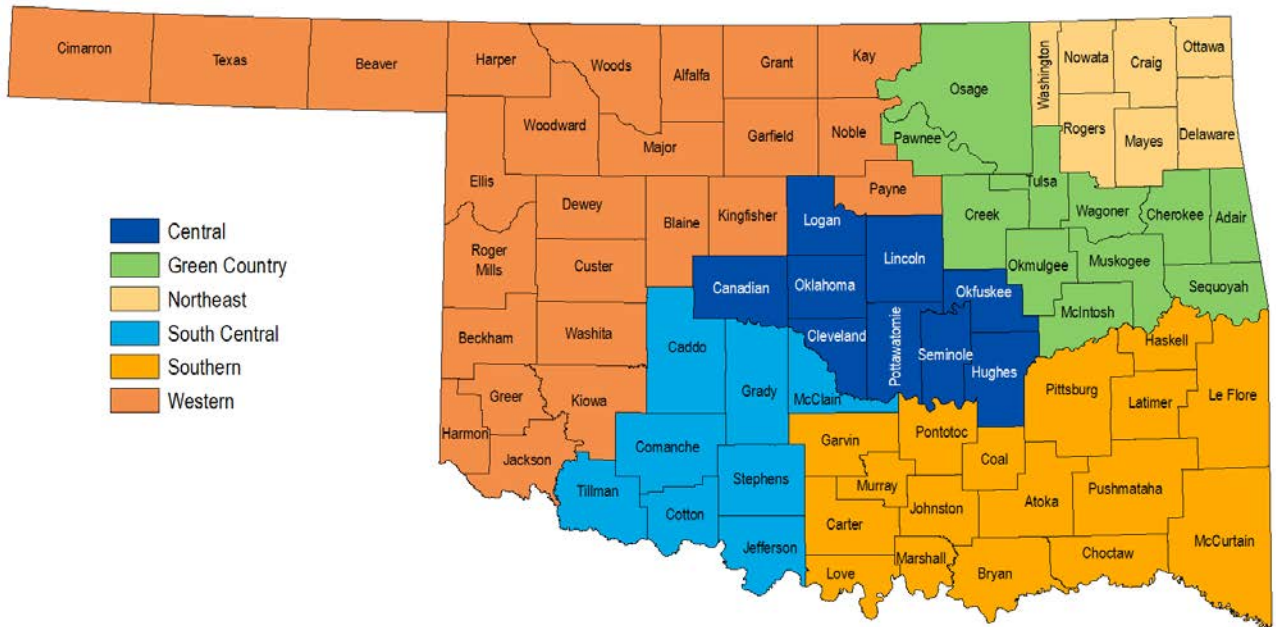
