

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – August 2021

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the month for most Oklahoma counties in August

In August, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 5.4 percent. **Tillman County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **McIntosh and Pittsburg Counties**. **Cimarron County** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.2 percent in August. Unemployment rates in August were lower than a year earlier in 76 of Oklahoma’s 77 counties and higher in one county.

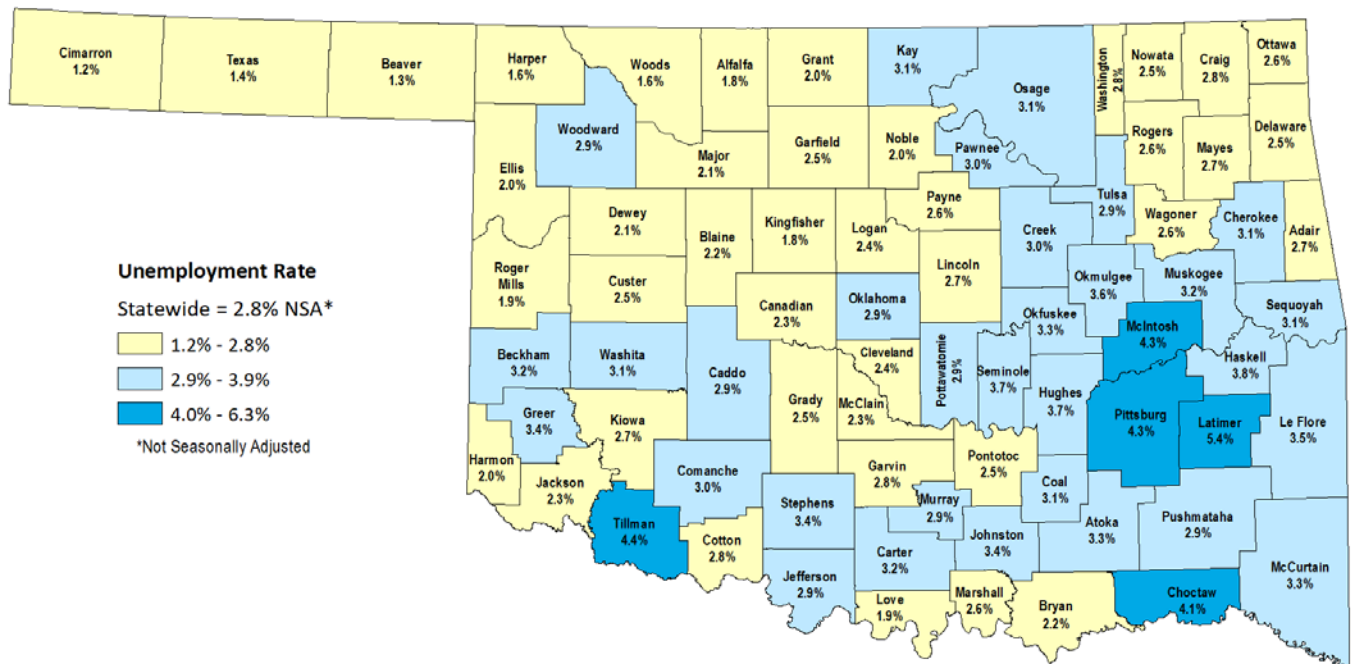
