

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – September 2021

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the month for all Oklahoma counties in September

In September, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 4.1 percent. **Tillman County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **McIntosh** and **Pittsburg Counties**. **Beaver, Cimarron, Texas, and Woods Counties** shared the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.0 percent in September. Unemployment rates in September were lower than a year earlier in 76 of Oklahoma’s 77 counties and higher in one county.

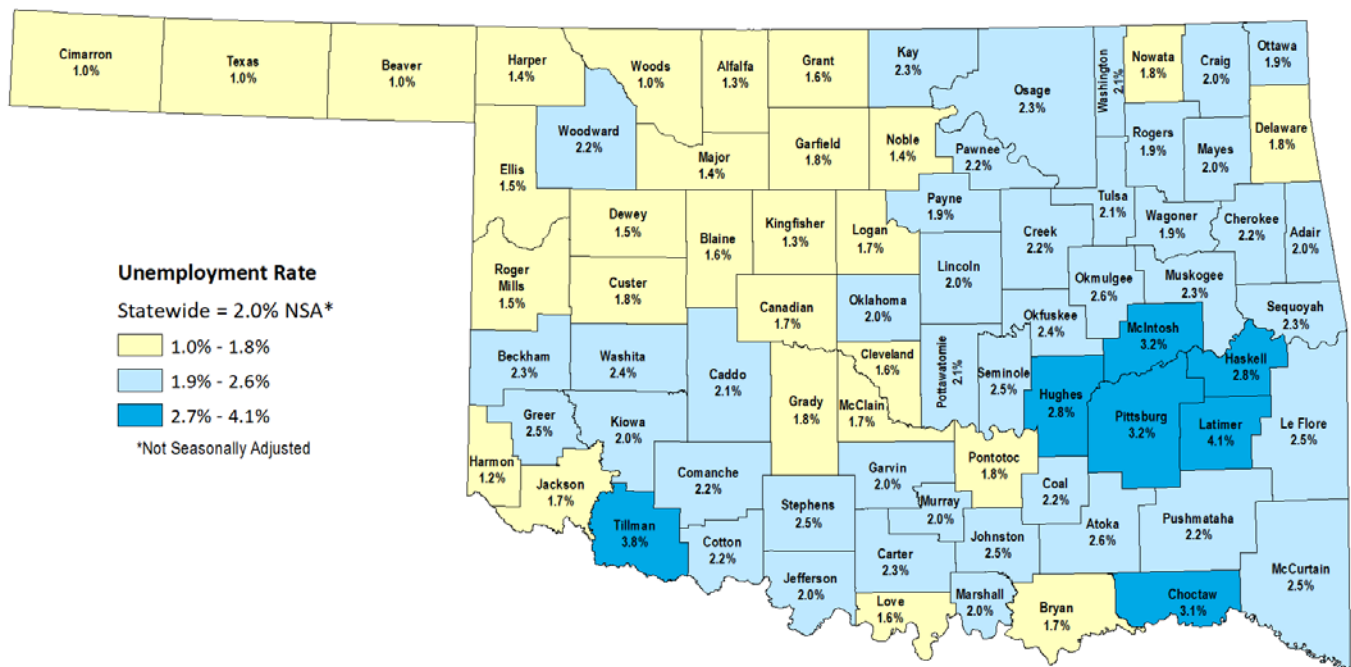
