

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – October 2021

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the month for most Oklahoma counties in October

In October, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 4.0 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Pittsburg County**. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 0.8 percent in October. Unemployment rates in October were lower than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma’s 77 counties.

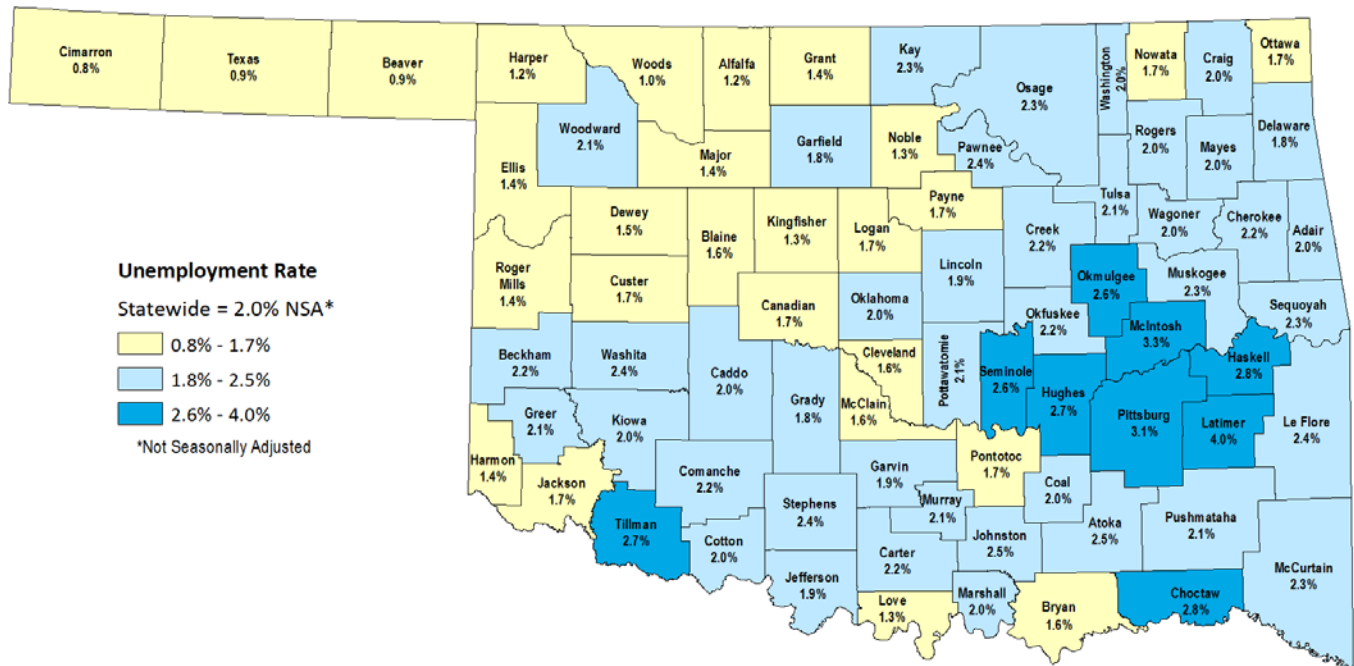

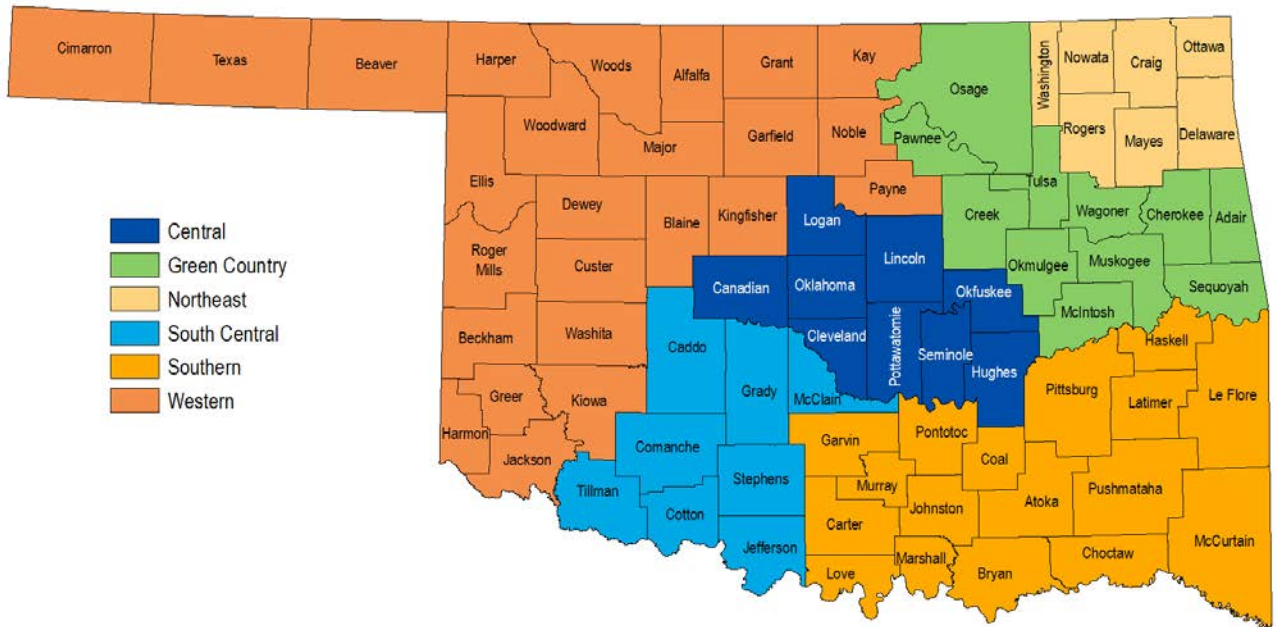
