

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – December 2021

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the month for most Oklahoma counties in December

In December, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 3.9 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Pittsburg County**. **Beaver, Cimarron, Texas, and Woods Counties** shared the lowest county unemployment rate of 0.8 percent in December. Unemployment rates in December were lower than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma’s 77 counties.

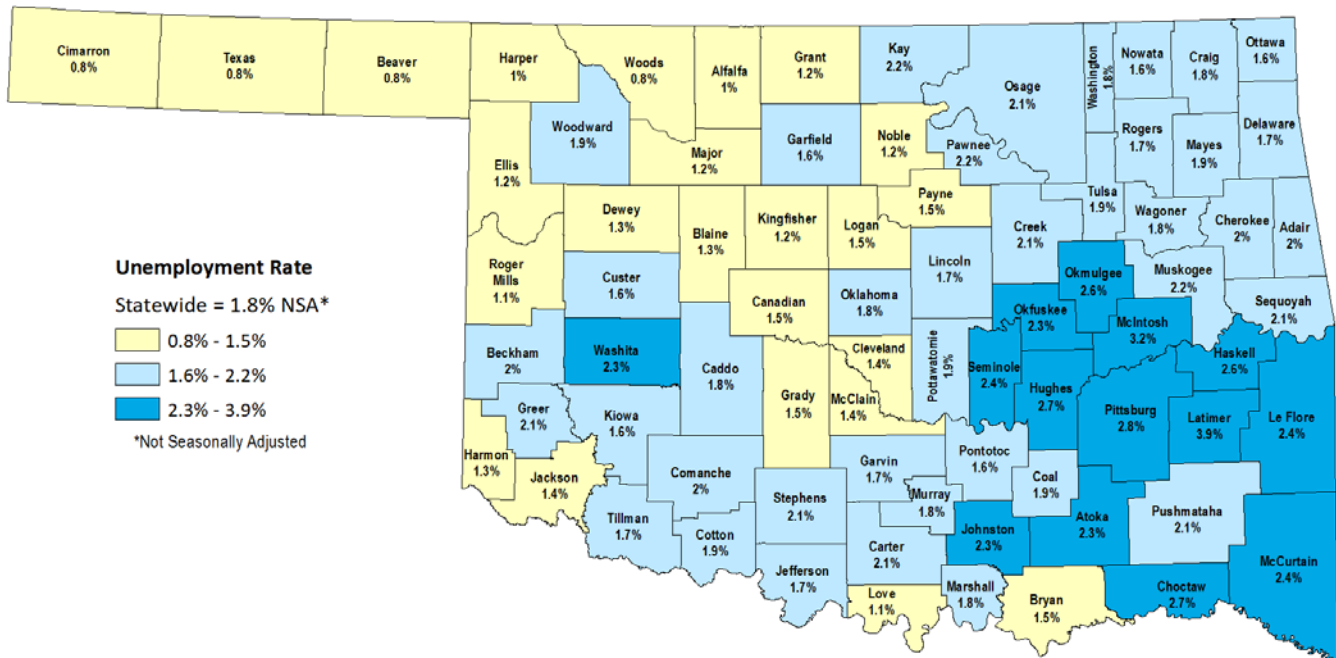
