In April, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 5.8 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Pittsburg County**. **Cimarron County** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.3 percent in April. Unemployment rates in April were lower than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma's 77 counties.


