

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – February 2022

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates up over the month for most Oklahoma counties in February

In February, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 6.6 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Pittsburg County**. **Cimarron County** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.3 percent in February. Unemployment rates in February were lower than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma’s 77 counties.

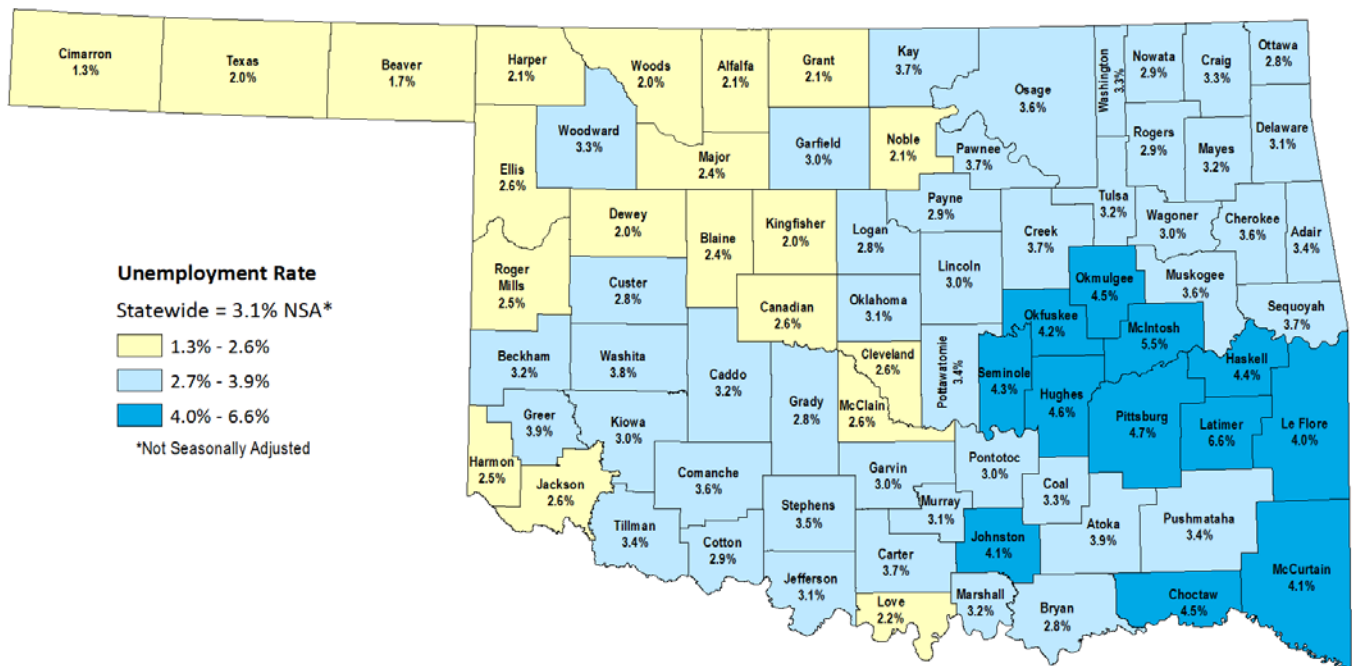

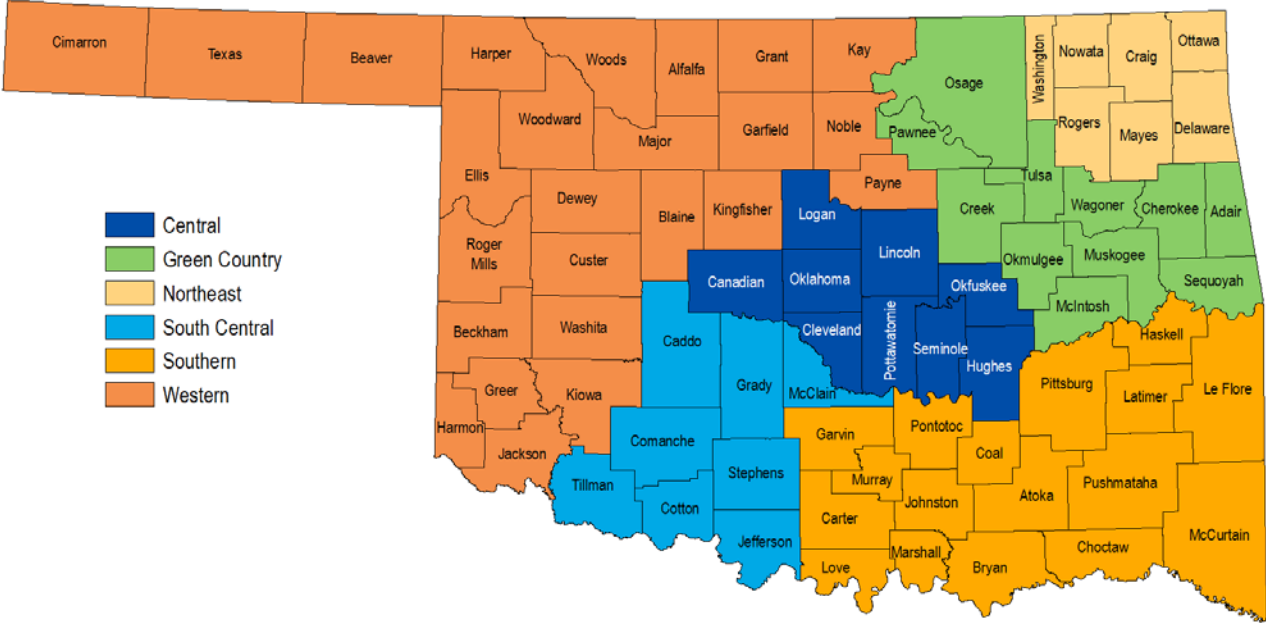
