

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – June 2022

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the year for most Oklahoma counties in June

In June, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 8.0 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Haskell County**. **Cimarron County** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.6 percent in June. Unemployment rates in June were lower than a year earlier in 75 of Oklahoma’s 77 counties, up in 1 county, and unchanged in 1 county.

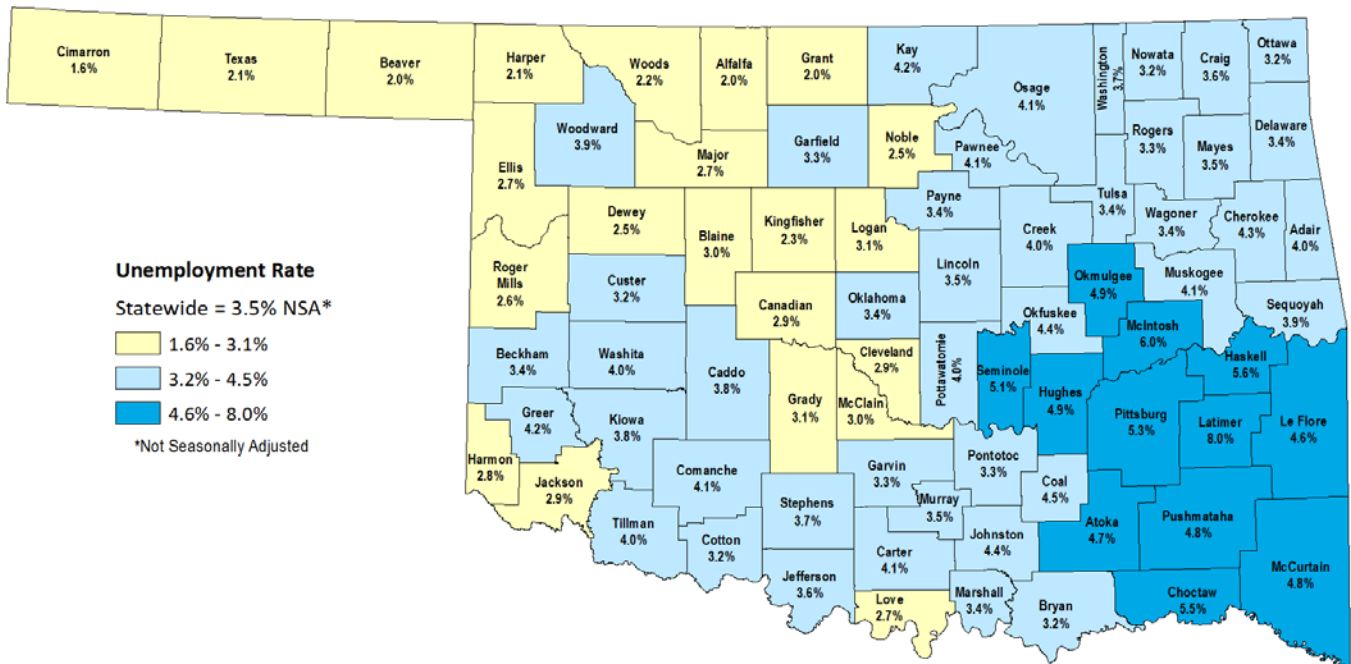

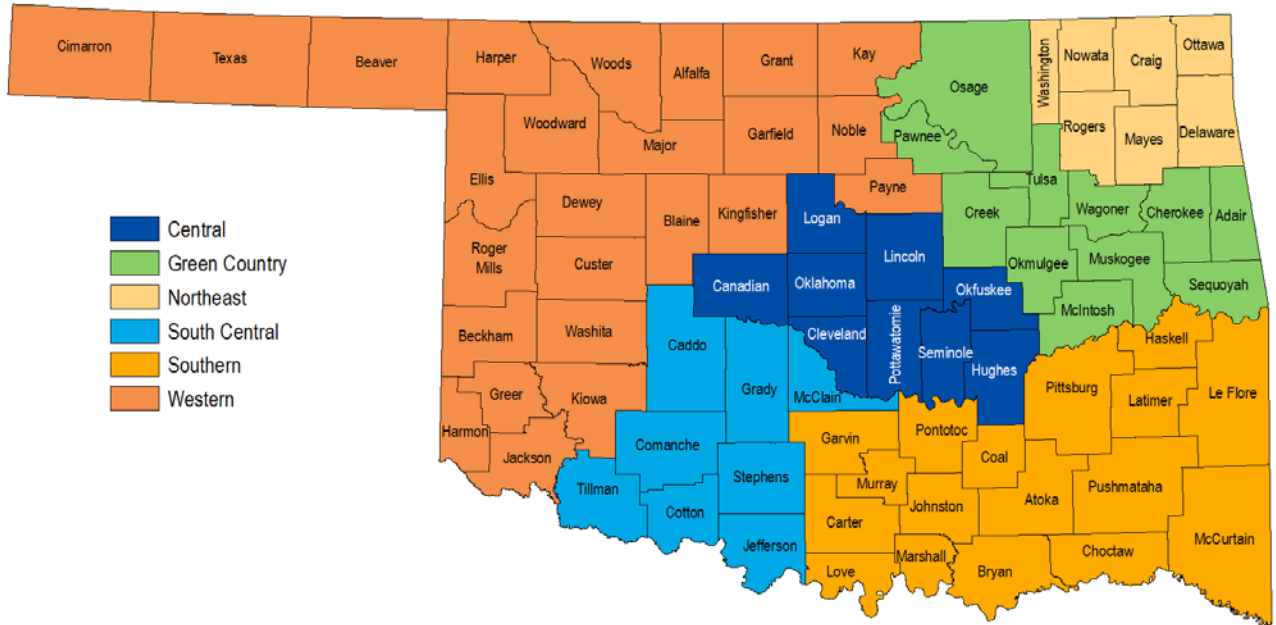
