

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – June 2023

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the year for most Oklahoma counties in June

In June, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 6.0 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Tillman County**. **Cimarron County** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.5 percent in June. Unemployment rates in June were lower than a year earlier in 69 counties, higher in 6 counties and unchanged in 2 counties.

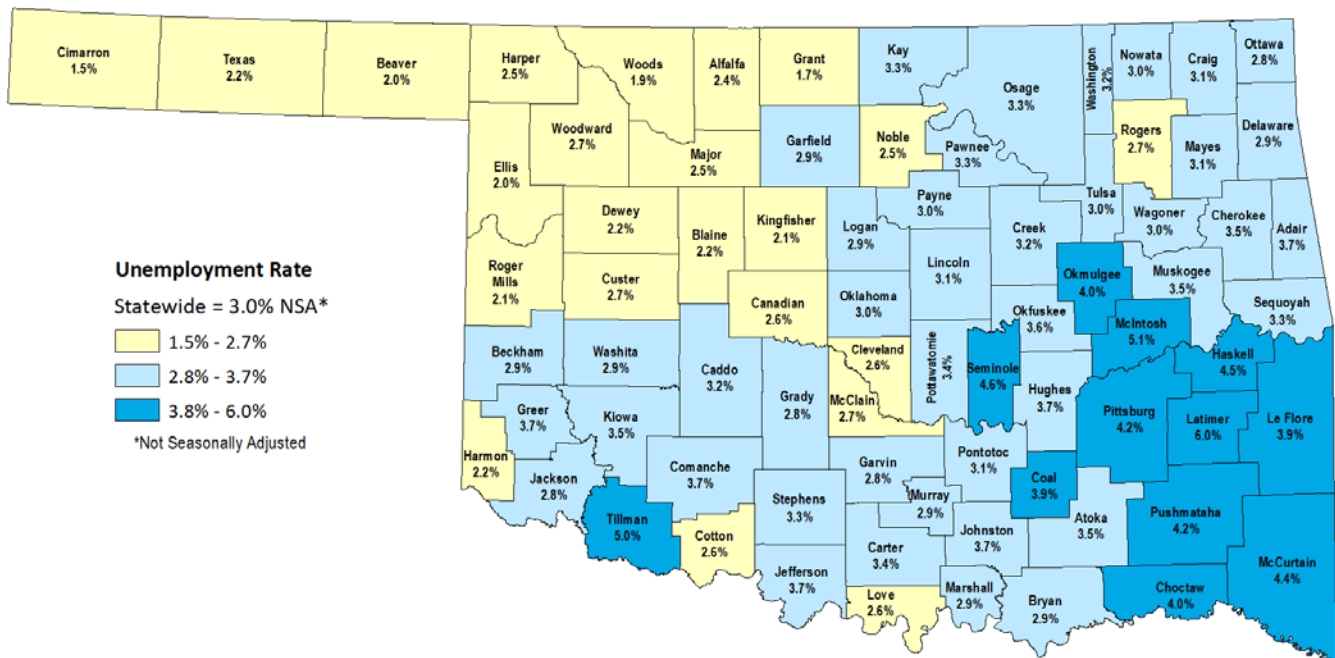

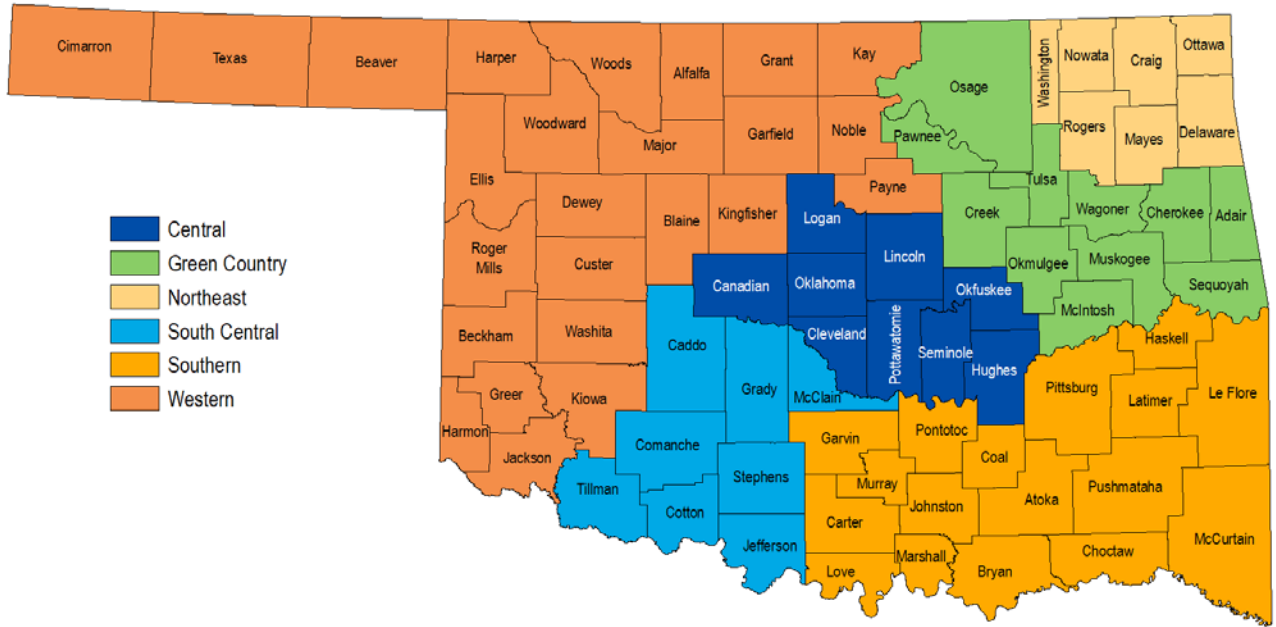
