Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

### Jobless rates up over the year for most Oklahoma counties in October

In October, **McIntosh County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 5.8 percent. **Haskell County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Seminole County**. **Beaver, Dewey and Woods Counties** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.1 percent in October. Unemployment rates in October were higher than a year earlier in 65 counties, lower in 9 counties and unchanged in 3 counties.


