

# OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – October 2024

## Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

### Jobless rates down over the year for most Oklahoma counties in October

In October, **Haskell County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 5.1 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month. **Dewey County** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.6 percent in October. Unemployment rates in October were higher than a year earlier in 3 counties and lower in 74 counties.

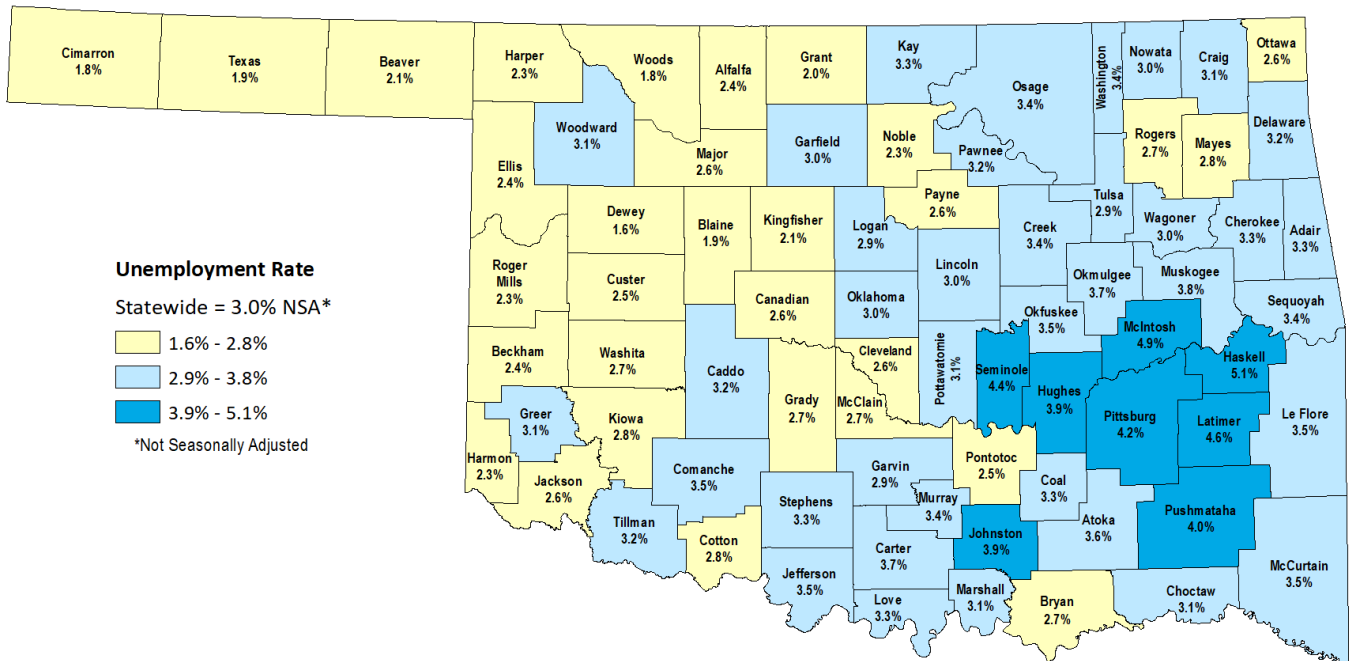

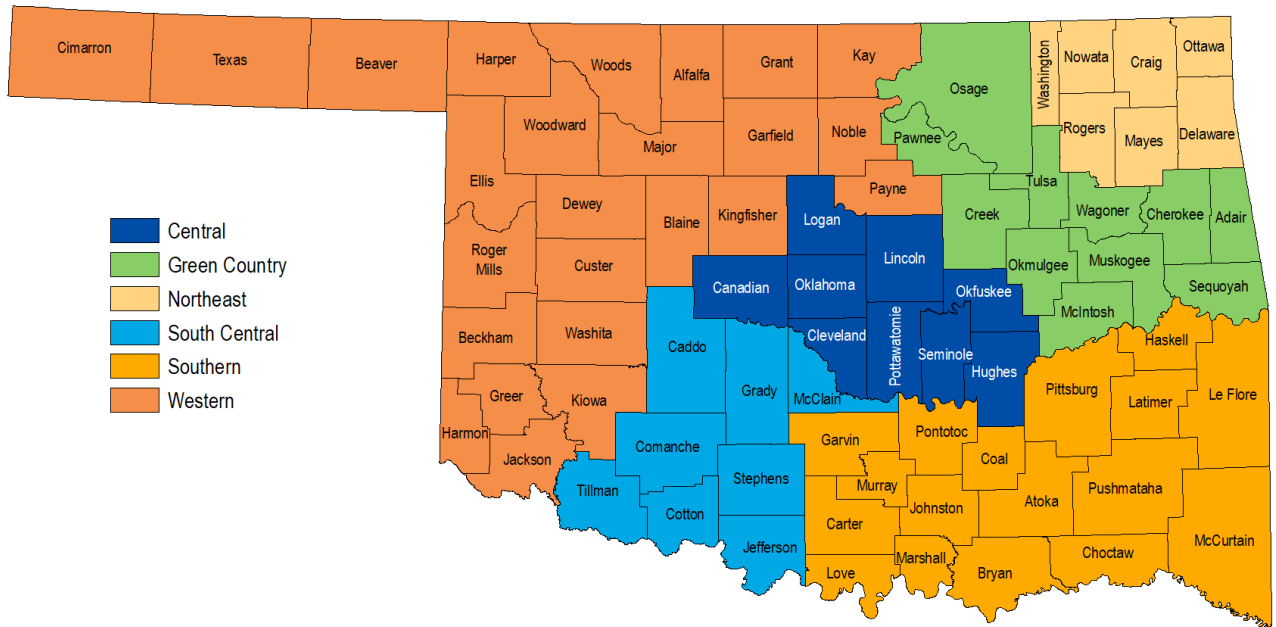
