

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – April 2025

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the year for most Oklahoma counties in April

In April, **Love** and **Pushmataha Counties** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 4.0 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month. **Texas** and **Dewey Counties** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.4 percent in April. Unemployment rates in April were lower than a year earlier in 68 counties, higher in 6 counties, and unchanged in 3 counties.

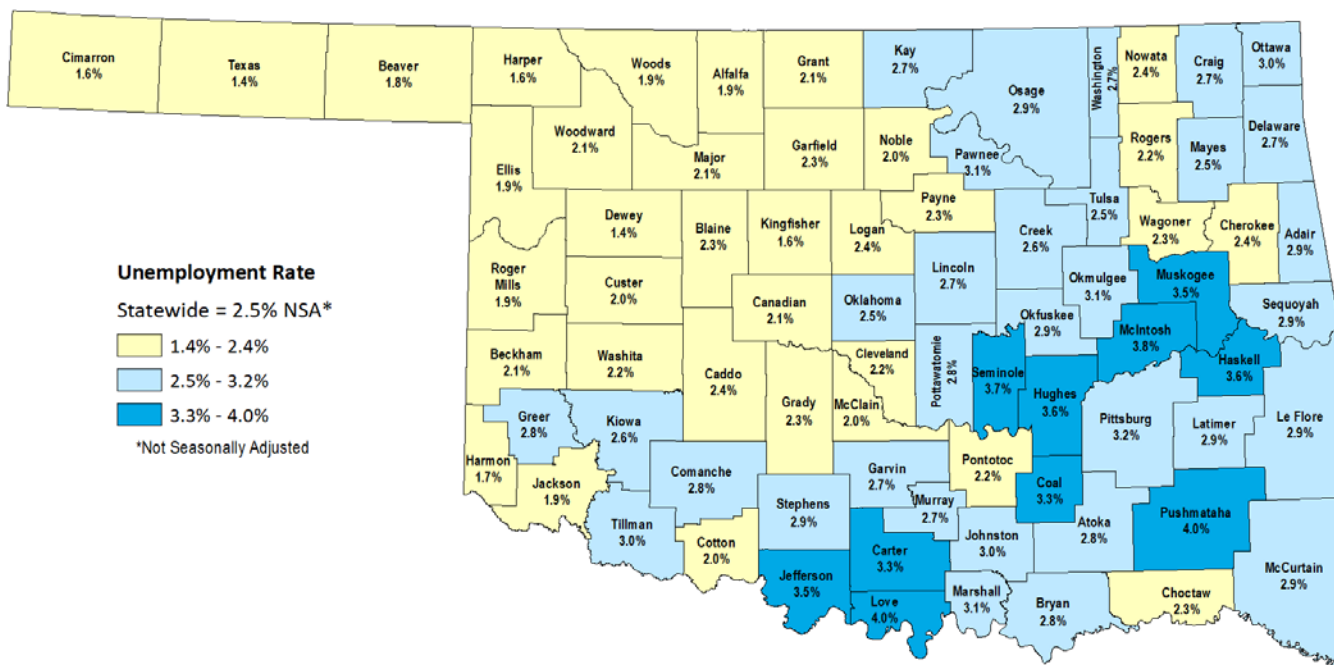

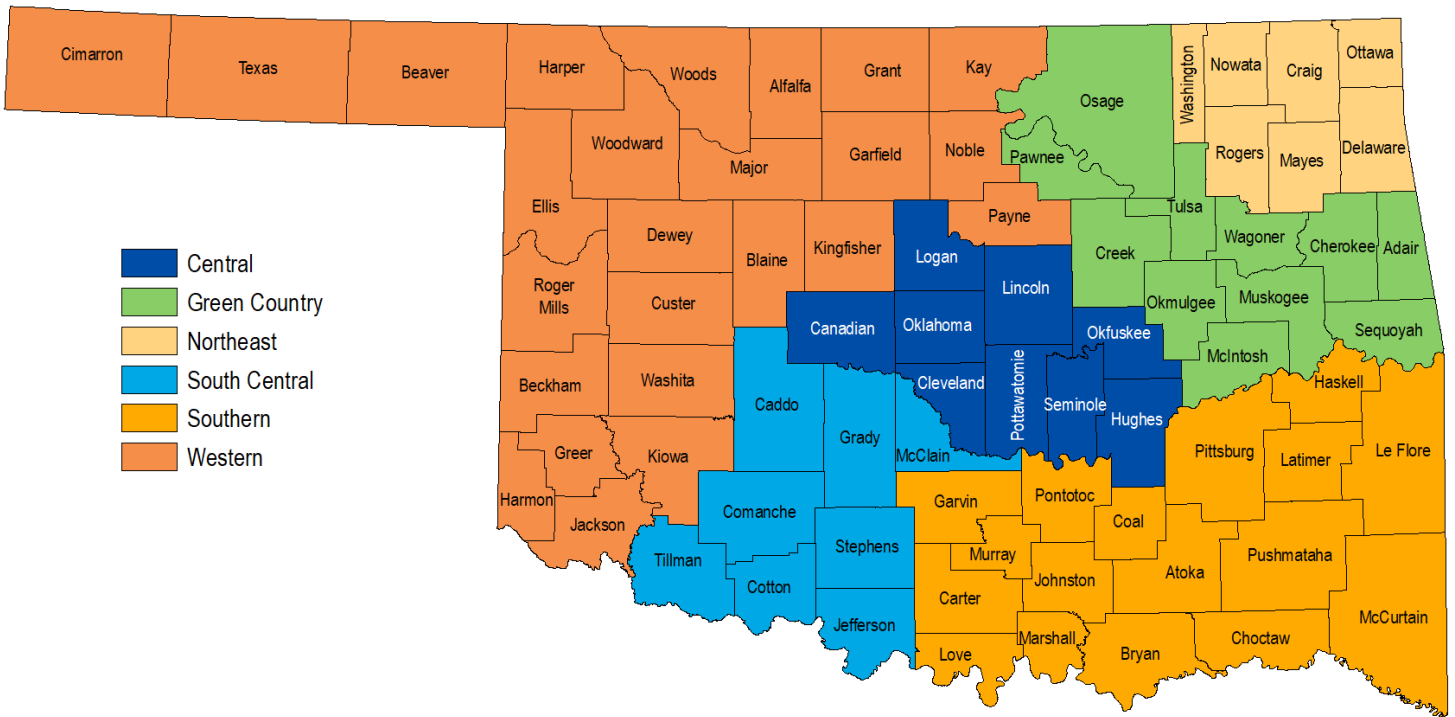
