

OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – December 2025

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates increased over the year in all Oklahoma counties in December

In December, **Love County** posted Oklahoma’s highest county unemployment rate of 6.5 percent. **Hughes County** reported the second-highest rate for the month. **Dewey** and **Texas Counties** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.2 percent in December. Unemployment rates in December were higher than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma’s 77 counties.

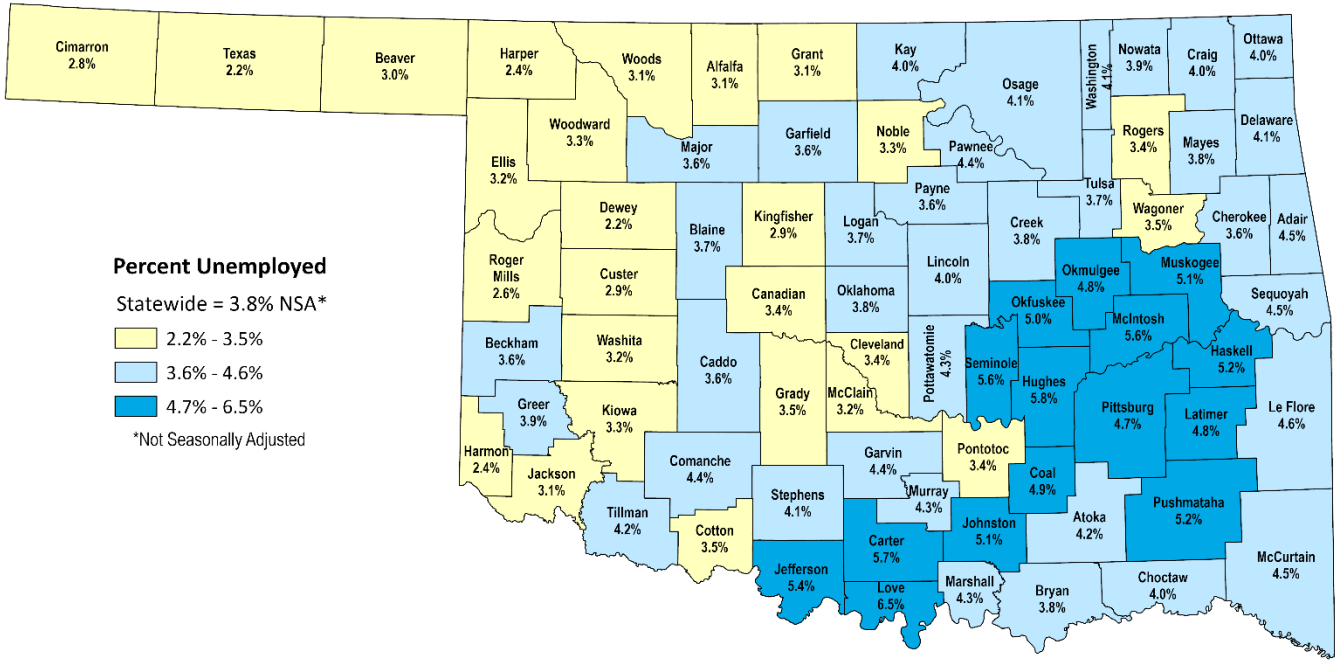

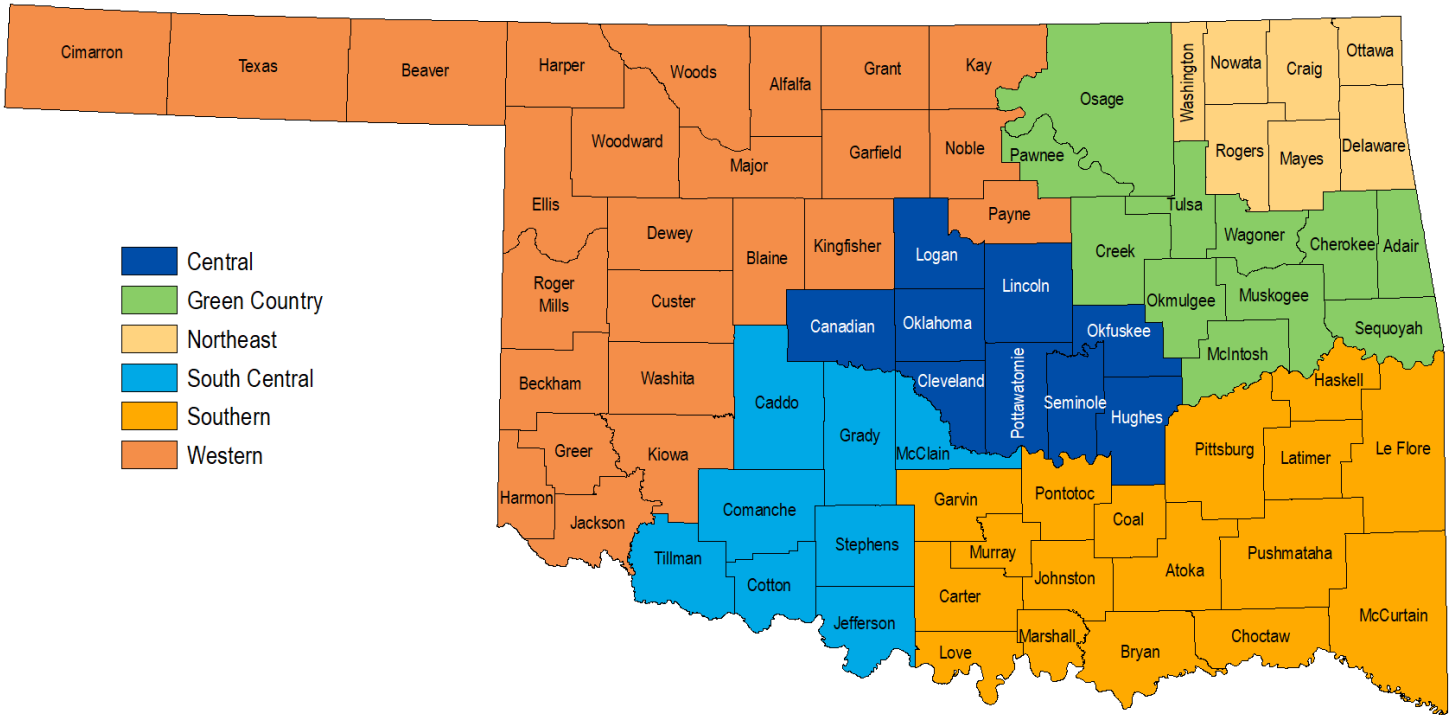
