Self-employed workers data are produced from the projection matrix system based on Oklahoma Occupational Employment Statistics(OES) survey and BLS Current Population Survey. Employment estimates have been rounded to the nearest 10. Percent change is based on unrounded data.

<sup>2</sup>Educational Services includes state and local government education.

<sup>3</sup>Health Care and Social Assistance includes state and local government hospitals.

<sup>4</sup>Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation includes casinos from local government.

<sup>5</sup>Accommodation and Food Services includes casino hotels from local government
