Covered employment data are from the Bureau of Labor Statistics(BLS) Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages(QCEW) program from Oklahoma Employment Security Commission. Self-employed workers data are produced from the projection matrix system based on Oklahoma Occupational Employment Statistics(OES) survey and BLS Current Population Survey. Employment estimates have been rounded to the nearest 10. Percent change is based on unrounded data.

²Educational Services includes state and local government education.

³Health Care and Social Assistance includes state and local government hospitals.

⁴Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation includes casinos from local government.

⁵Accommodation and Food Services includes casino hotels from local government
