



Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessment (RESEA) Attendance Policy

The Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessment (RESEA) program is designed to help individuals return to work as quickly as possible. Individuals are offered the ability to schedule this appointment at times that are convenient for them.

Individuals have until the date printed on the notice of eligibility letter to complete this requirement or their Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits will be stopped.

Individuals must review and accept the below attendance policy to maintain UI benefit eligibility:

- Schedule and attend RESEA appointment before the deadline printed in the eligibility letter received via mail and e-mail.
 - Canceling and rescheduling appointments DOES NOT change the given deadline.
- Schedule and attend all RESEA follow up appointments and activities before stated deadlines.
- Complete all required pre-appointment activities prior to attending appointment.
 - Go to www.okjobmatch.com to complete work registration.
 - Watch the [Online RESEA Orientation](#) prior to your appointment.
 - RESEA appointments are virtual. Please let us know if a reasonable accommodation is needed by contacting a local [Oklahoma Works office](#).
- Remember to join scheduled appointments on time.
 - Individuals who do not attend their appointment at the scheduled time will be marked absent, and their UI benefits will be stopped. Individuals will receive a letter in the mail with a formal explanation. Individuals must use the scheduling tool to reschedule their appointment, and they must attend the appointment to reinstate their UI benefits.
- If the scheduled appointment can't be attended, please cancel and reschedule the appointment via the scheduling tool before the appointment time.
 - Please note, available appointment slots may differ from day-to-day.
