At the November 20, 2025, Commission Meeting the Commission approved the permanent rulemaking process to consider proposed amendments to open certain chapters in Rules of Racing: Changes are proposed in the following chapters: Rules of Racing and Racetrack Gaming including Chapters 1, 15, 25, 45, 65, 70, 75.

Rules of Racing:

Chapter 1, Commission Powers and Jurisdiction
Chapter 15, Licensing
Chapter 25, Entries and Declarations
Chapter 45, Prohibited Practices and Equine Testing
Chapter 65, Pari-Mutuel Wagering
Chapter 70, Objections and Protests: Hearing and Appeals
Chapter 75, Oklahoma- Bred Program

Consideration:

The Commission provided the Secretary of State, The Cabinet Secretary, and the Governor's office of General Counsel proposed rule amendments as authorized at the Commission's November meeting. The Notice of Permanent Rulemaking intent was published in the Oklahoma Register, public comment was taken, and a hearing on each chapter was conducted.
