CONSENT ORDER

The Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing under the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act and both parties agree as follows:

- (1) The Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference, the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter:
 - i. The Respondent is a registered limited liability company with the Oklahoma Secretary of State, filing number: 3512311361.
 - ii. The Respondent transacts business at 3718 NW 23rd Street, Oklahoma City, OK 73107.
 - iii. The Respondent is a licensed precious metal and gem dealer in the State of Oklahoma, license number PM007511.
 - iv. An inspection of the Respondent's precious metal and gem transactions was conducted by the Petitioner, attached and incorporated by reference herein, on November 25, 2013.
 - v. The Report of Inspection, dated November 25, 2013, states that Respondent's employees were not licensed with the Department as precious metal and gem employees.
 - vi. The Report of Inspection, attached and

incorporated by reference, dated November 25, 2013, states that the Respondent failed to list the license number on advertising signage and Respondent's internet website.

- (2) The Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order.
- (3) The Respondent agrees to pay a \$250.00 civil penalty. Payment of the civil penalty shall be received, by the Department, five days prior to the hearing date in the Notice of Hearing.
- (4) The Respondent agrees to comply with the Precious Metal and Gem Dealer Licensing Act. 59 O.S. § 1521 et seq.
- (5) Payment shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 14-0021-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of Roy John Martin, General Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 3613 N.W. 56th Street, Suite 240, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112.
- (6) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned by United States mail to the Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.
- (7) If the Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 1528(G) of the Precious Metal and Gem Dealer Licensing Act.
